Williams of Petersfield are delighted to offer this extended four-bedroom semi-detached home, with 1676.00ft² of floorspace. Conveniently positioned within easy walking distance of Petersfield town centre, with its range of shops, schools and mainline station whilst it is also ideally located for the Heath and Goodyer Meadows, which gives access to miles of countryside walking. Well presented throughout, the property combines character features with practical modern living, and homes of this size with ample parking and garden space so close to town are seldom available.

The ground floor comprises an entrance hall, a bright bay-fronted living room with feature fireplace, and a spacious open-plan kitchen/dining/family room spanning the rear of the house. The contemporary kitchen is fitted with white gloss units, integrated dishwasher and generous worktop space, with ample room for both dining and seating. Bi-fold doors open directly onto the rear garden, creating an ideal space for everyday family life and entertaining. A separate utility room and cloakroom complete the ground floor.

On the first floor are three well-proportioned double bedrooms, including one with ensuite, along with a modern family bathroom. The converted loft provides a generous fourth double bedroom with its own ensuite shower room, offering flexible accommodation for guests, older children or home working.

To the front, a private driveway provides off-road parking for several vehicles alongside a mature garden. The rear garden is a particular feature, private, established and enjoying sun for much of the day, with plenty of space for outdoor dining, play or relaxing. There is also a large separate Garden Room with an ensuite which could be perfect for an additional children's play space, home office, guest room or somewhere to operate a business from.

Location

Petersfield is a market town and civil parish in the East Hampshire district of Hampshire. It is 17 miles north of Portsmouth on the A3 road. The town has its own railway station on the Portsmouth direct line, the mainline rail link- connecting Portsmouth and London (Waterloo). The town is situated on the northern slopes of the South Downs. Petersfield lies wholly within an area of outstanding natural beauty and within the boundary of the South Downs National Park. The town is on the crossroads of the well-used north-south (A3) and east-west (A272) routes and it originally grew as a coach stop on the Portsmouth to London route. Petersfield is twinned with Barentin in France and Warendorf in Germany. Petersfield is a popular location for families, due to the choices of schools available, including; Churchers College, The Petersfield School (TPS) Herne Junior school and a number of infant schools and playgroups nearby. The town centre offers a good selection of shops and facilities, including Waitrose, Tescos and Lidl supermarkets and a mixture of High street brands and local independent businesses. Being within the South Downs National Park there are a plethora of country walks and cycle paths and the jewel in the Town's crown is the Heath & Lake.

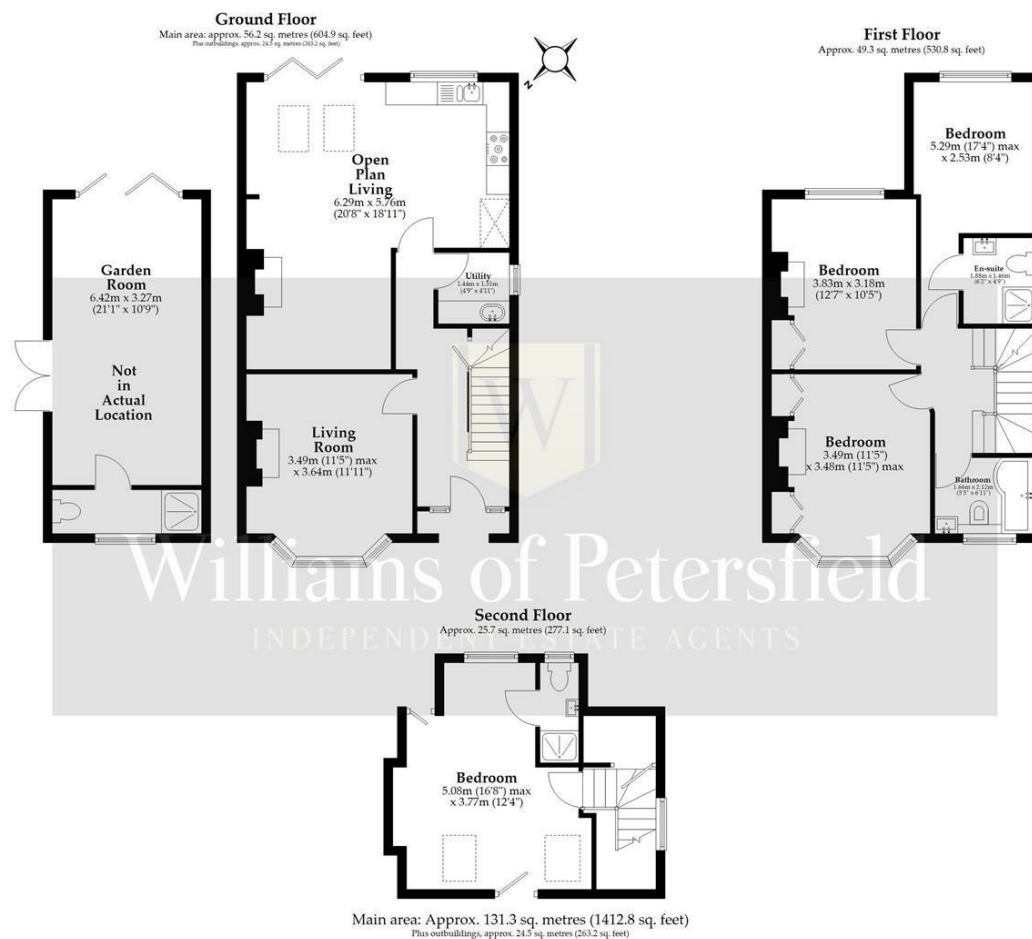
