Externally, to the front the property has a driveway proving off-street parking, to the rear is a lovely low-maintenance enclosed garden.



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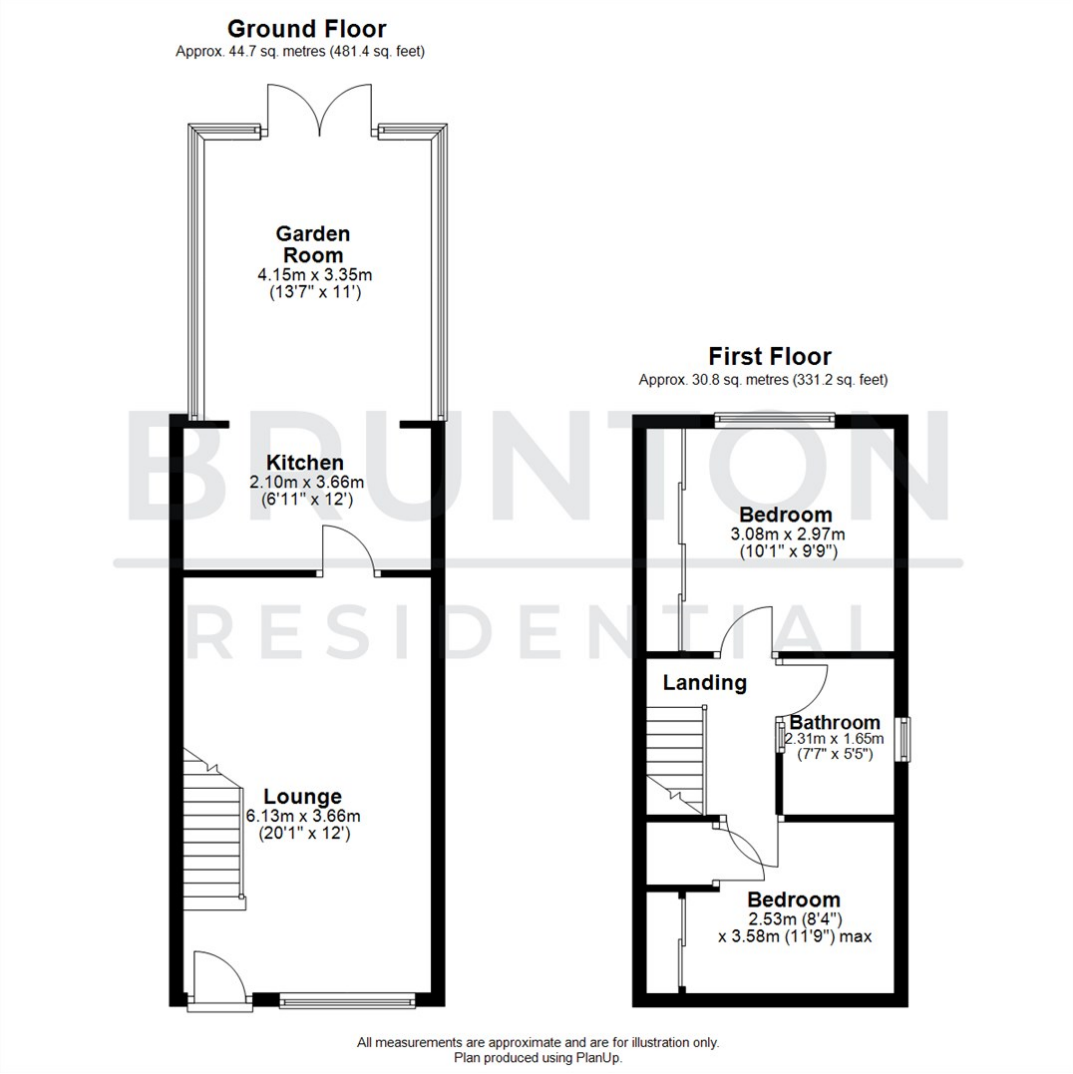
