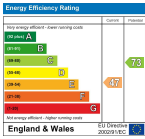
SITUATION

The property is situated in a rural situation with countryside views over the valley. The village of Maiden Newton is close by which has a good range of local amenities such as including shops, first school, garage, doctors surgery, railway station. The village of Maiden Newton is about 8 miles to the north-west of Dorchester. Dorchester provides a comprehensive range of shopping, educational and recreational facilities including the county hospital and mainline railway station to London/Waterloo. The market town of Bridport is approximately 10 miles away and offers a range of amenities as well as access to the Jurassic Coast.

Follow the road to Wynford Eagle (don't turn right to Bridport) and continue for approx. 1.5 miles. The cottage will be found on your right before Higher Wynford Farm.
