Rich History & Heritage –The Bromley family seat, historically known as Baddington Hall, dates to the reign of Edward III. Hack Green, a small, dispersed settlement within the parish, houses a fascinating former secret underground bunker and regional defence headquarters.

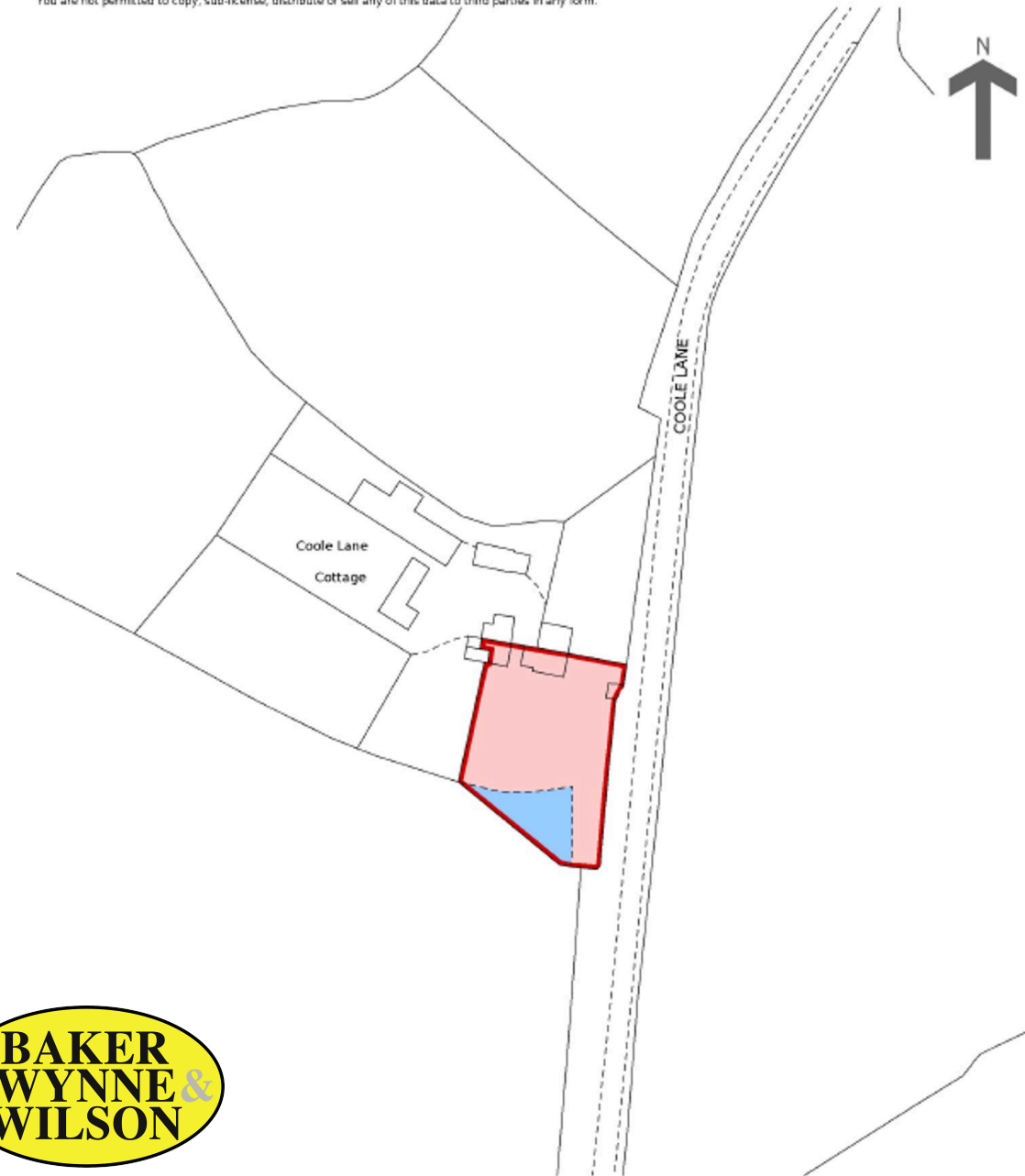

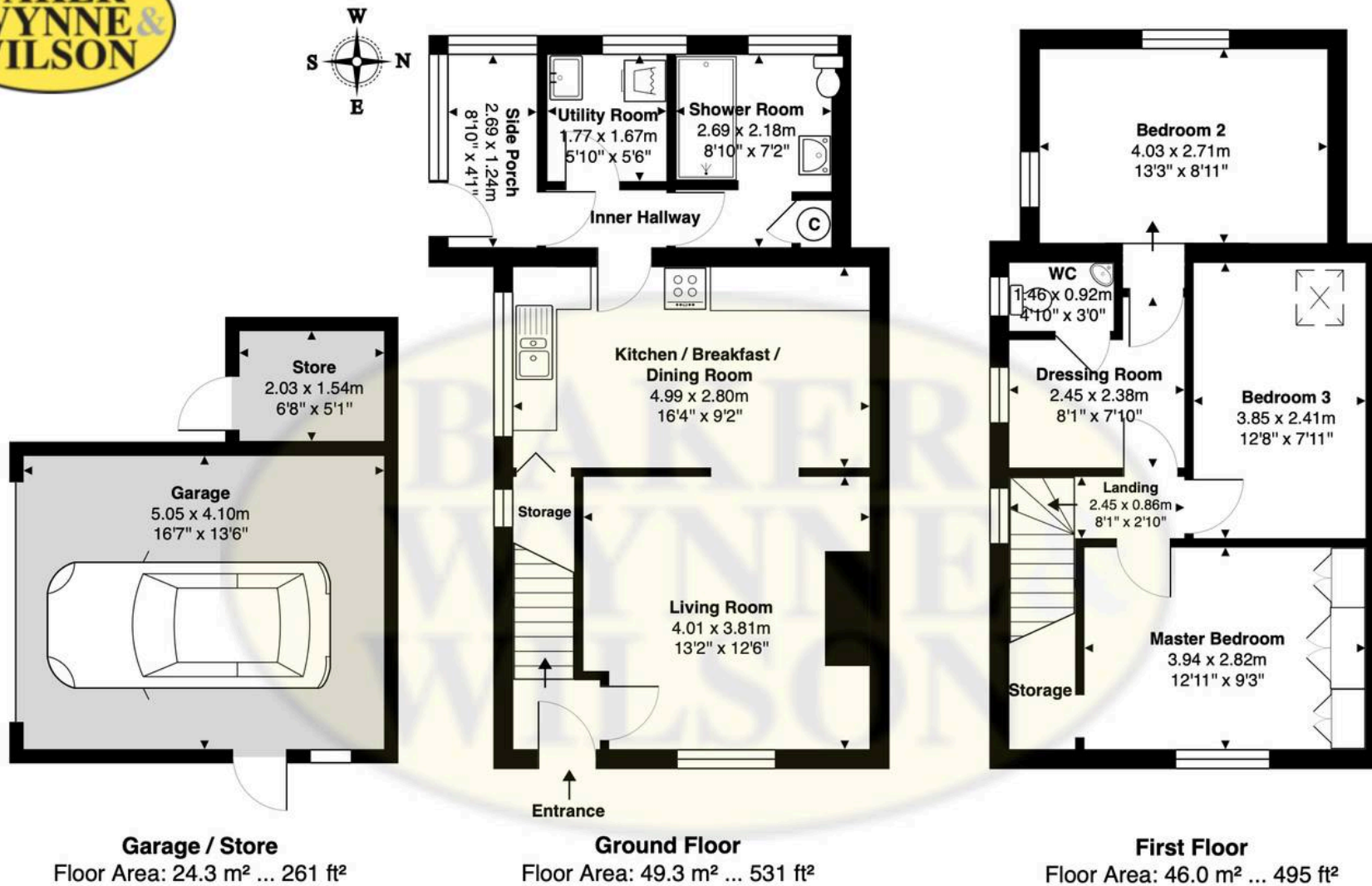
