Situated in the semi-rural yet highly accessible setting of Burham Village, this well-presented two-bedroom Victorian terrace offers character, charm and exceptional outdoor space — with countryside views to both the front and rear.

The accommodation is arranged over two floors and blends period character with modern comfort.

The ground floor comprises a welcoming sitting room to the front, a separate dining room ideal for entertaining, a stylish modern kitchen, and a useful additional room currently utilised as a store but offering potential to be converted into a cloakroom (subject to any necessary consents).

Upstairs, there are two well-proportioned bedrooms and a separate modern first-floor bathroom — a layout that retains the home's traditional feel while offering practical modern living.

Externally, the property truly stands out. To the rear is a remarkable 280ft south-westerly facing garden, enjoying sunshine throughout the day and offering a wonderful mix of landscaped areas and more natural space — ideal for keen gardeners, families, or those simply wanting exceptional outdoor room.

Further benefits include double glazing, gas central heating via a combination boiler fitted in 2026, and a small front garden setting the house back from the road.

A rare opportunity to acquire a character home with outstanding garden length and views, all within easy reach of transport links and local amenities.

Burham village radiates a strong sense of community, with horses still cantering along its roads from local stables and walkers revelling in the breath-taking beauty of the Kent Downs. And for those who crave the hustle and bustle of city life, buses run regularly to Rochester, Chatham, and Maidstone. Plus, Burham village is a mere 23-minute drive (14 miles) from Ebbsfleet International Station, offering frequent trains to London St. Pancras in as little as 19 minutes.



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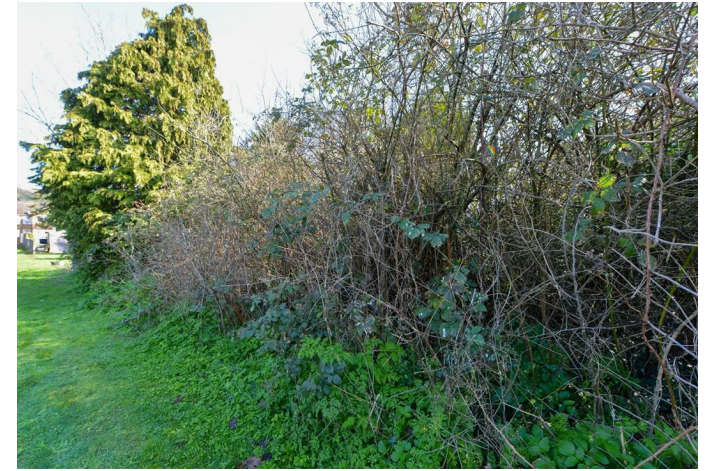

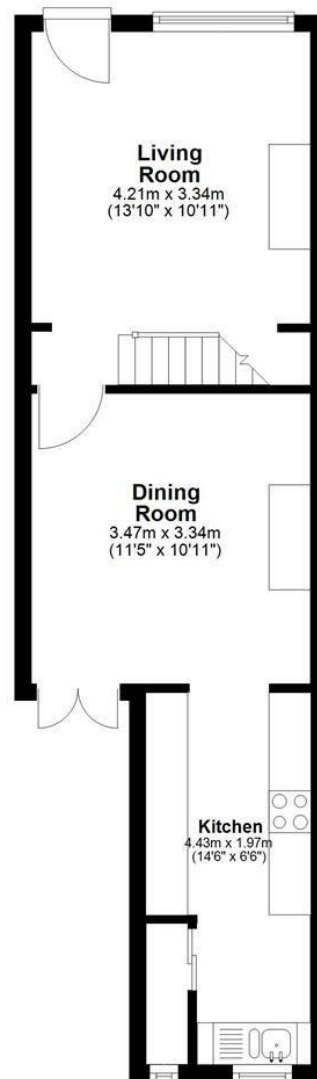

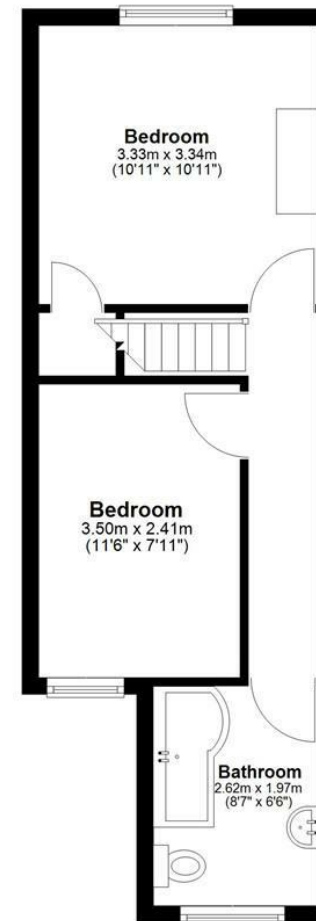


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Ground Floor
