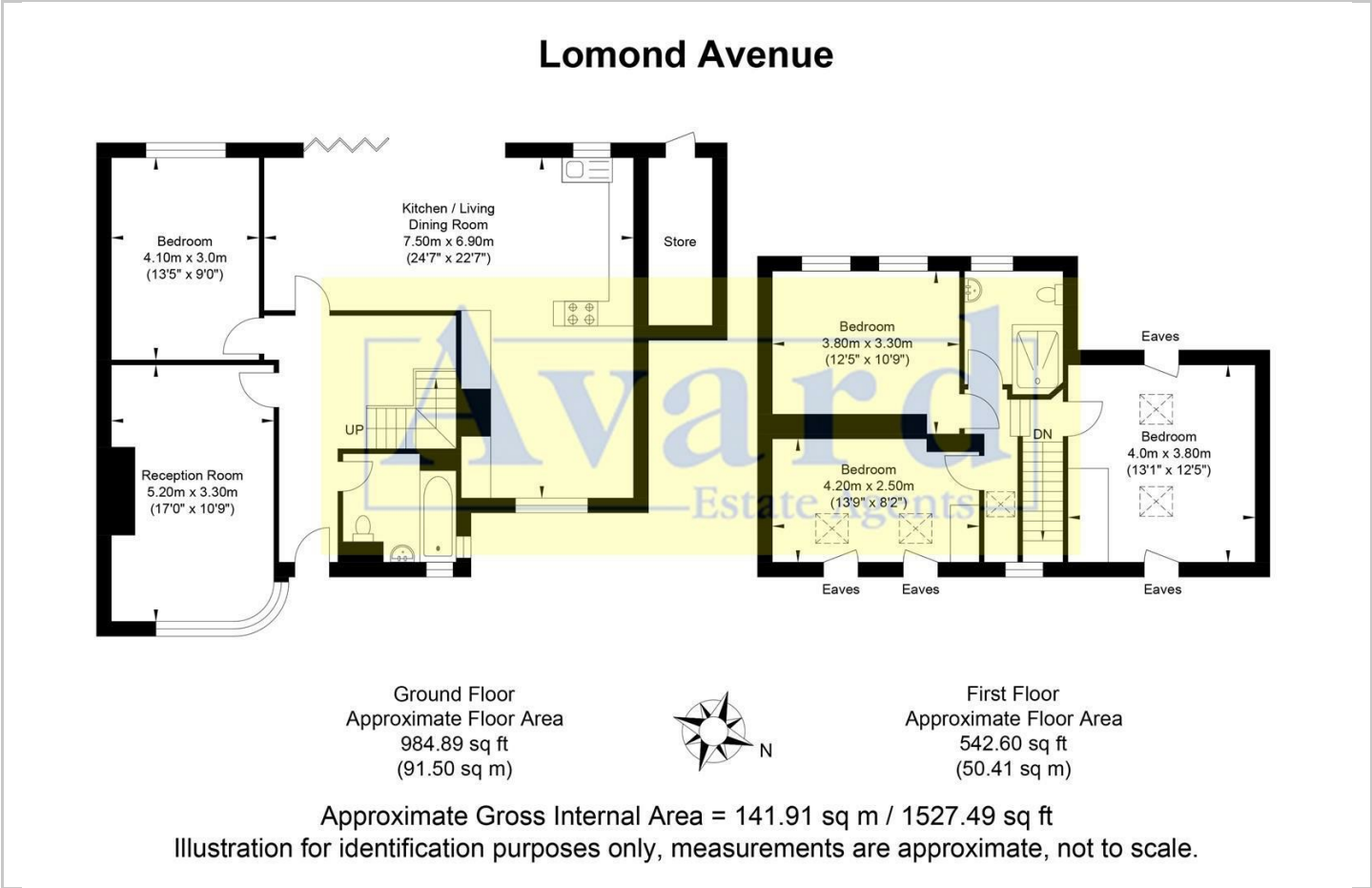




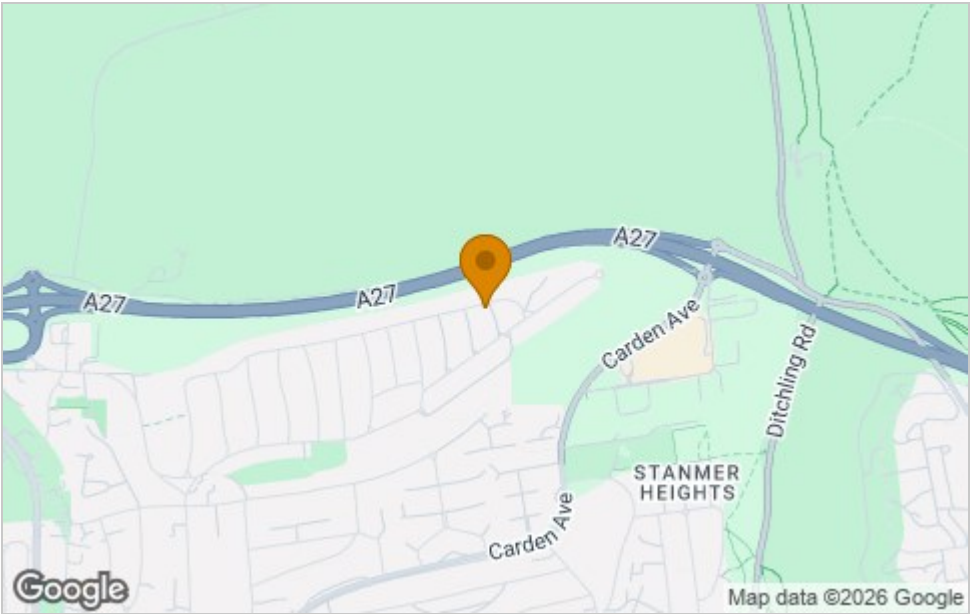

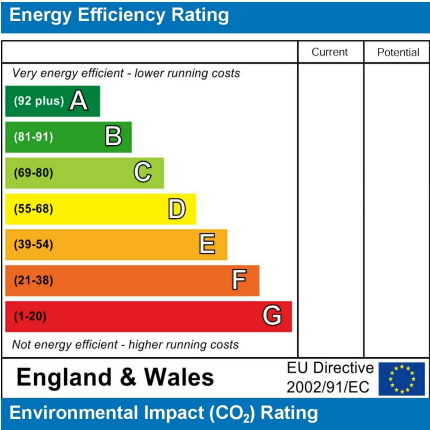
Floor Plan
