BEDROOMS

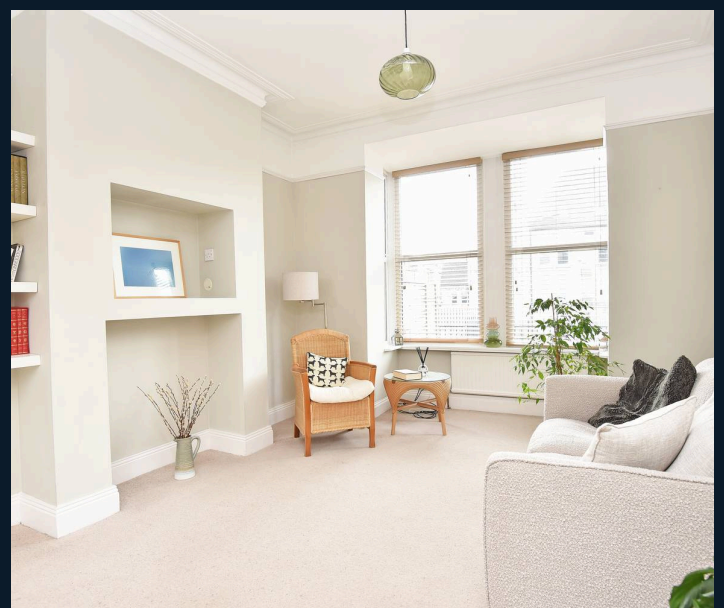
There are two bedrooms on the first floor, one double, one single.
