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DESCRIPTION

Located in a highly sought after residential road convenient for schools, town centre and local amenities being approached over a paved driveway is this adaptable four bedroom detached family home in need of some modernisation. The entrance door leads into a hallway with access to the downstairs WC, living room, dining room, kitchen and utility room. The cloakroom has a matching white suite comprising of a low level WC and wash hand basin. The lounge/diner has a window to rear aspect and patio doors leading into the conservatory. The kitchen overlooks the front and has wall and base units, inbuilt oven, gas hob and a door leading to the utility area. The utility has a sink and plumbing for a washing machine as well as useful storage units, space for a fridge/freezer, tiled flooring and access to the front and rear garden. Upstairs there are three double bedrooms plus a fourth single bedroom, all with UPVC double glazed windows,

radiators and power points, family bathroom with obscure UPVC glazed window, sink, low level WC, heated towel rail and walk in shower. The enclosed south facing rear garden is mostly laid to lawn with a patio seating area and side access to the front.

SITUATION

Shaftesbury is an ancient Saxon hilltop town enjoying superb views over the surrounding countryside. It has a good range of facilities including supermarkets, theatre, banks, schools, cafes, inns, restaurants, small hospital, dentists, health centre, Churches, and shops including High Street names such as Boots, W H Smiths, Superdrug, and Costa. There are local bus and long distance coach services, Gillingham about 5 miles away, has a main line railway station on the Exeter / Waterloo line. The A303 is approximately 7 miles to the north giving access to the South-West and to London. The cathedral city of Salisbury is approximately 22 miles,

and the Dorset Coast is approximately 35 miles away.




Directions
