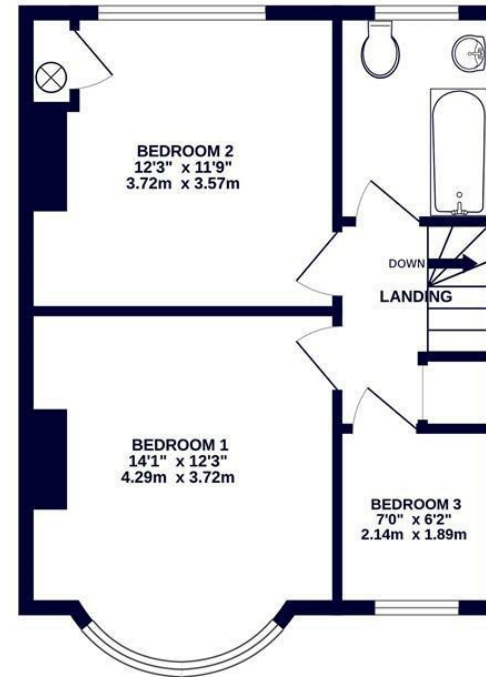




GROUND FLOOR

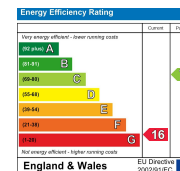
