THE PROPERTY

This charming two-bedroom cottage is ideally positioned in the highly sought-after village of Lavenham. To the first floor are two well-proportioned bedrooms, one of which benefits from an integrated storage cupboard for added practicality. To the rear, the property enjoys a private, low-maintenance garden, providing a pleasant outdoor space to relax and enjoy.

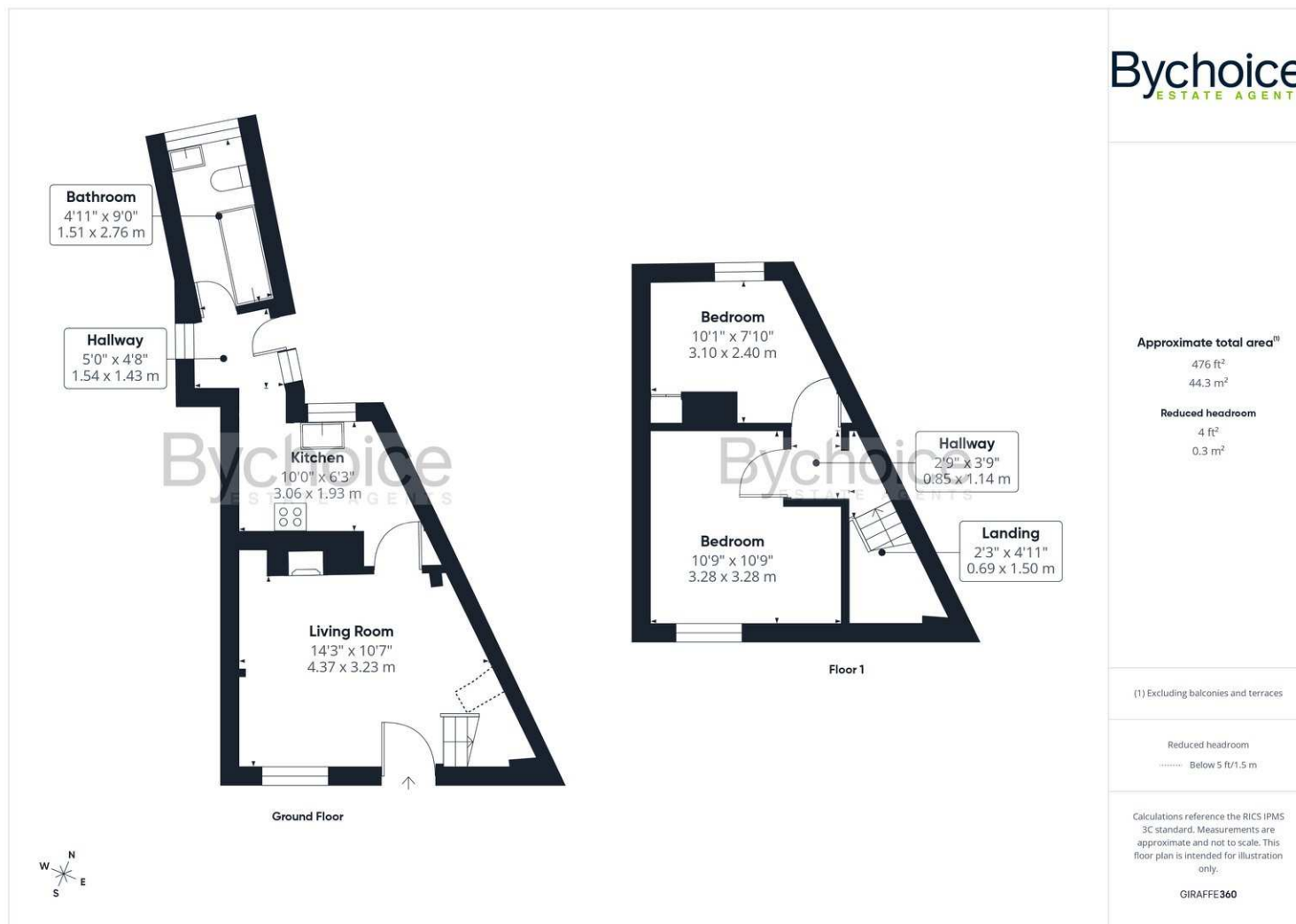

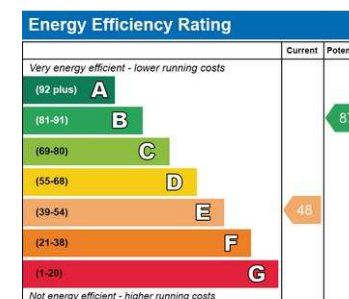
