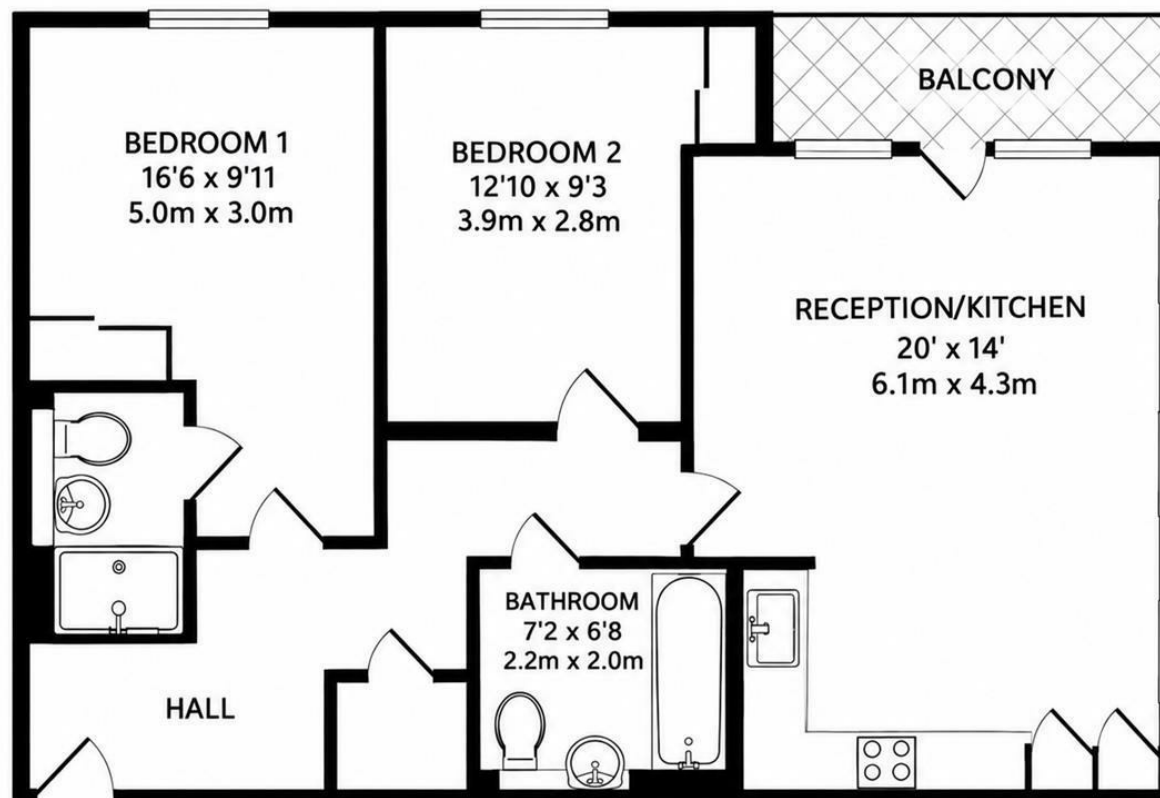

HARLEQUIN COURT HA4 TOTAL APPROX. FLOOR AREA 784 SQ.FT. (72.8 SQ.M.)

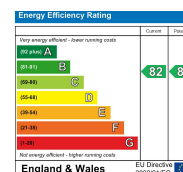
