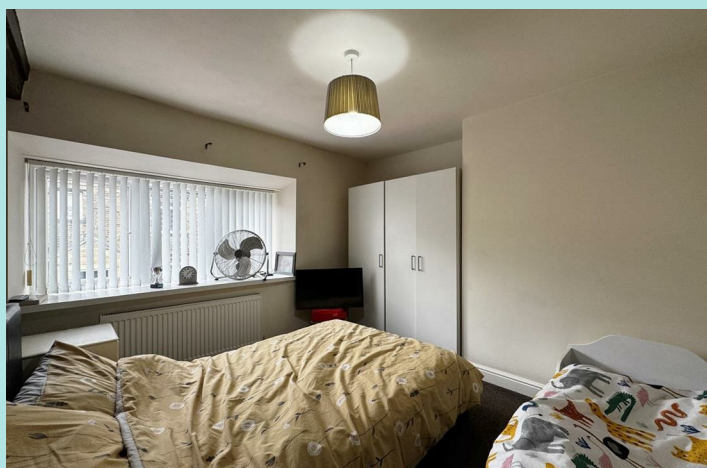

Accommodation:

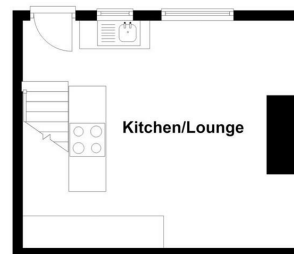
Entering into the open plan Lounge/Kitchen benefiting from a range of base, drawer & wall units with an integrated electric oven and four ring electric hob with extractor hood above, with additional space for plumbing for a washing machine and fridge. Lounge having traditional timber beams and stove effect electric fire adding to the character of the home. Further storage is available in the cellar which benefits from power/lighting. Upstairs there is a sizeable landing area providing access to a double master bedroom to the front elevation, and second bedroom also to the front elevation. The house bathroom has a three piece suite comprising low flush WC, sink, and bath with over bath mains fed shower & screen, plus a chrome finish heated towel rail.

Location:

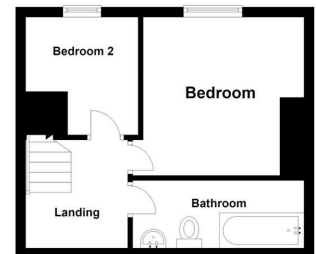

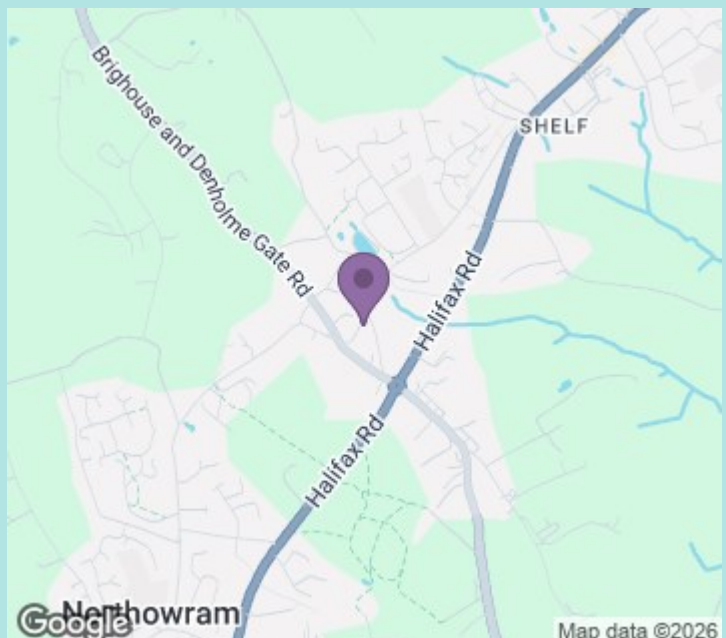
Ground Floor
