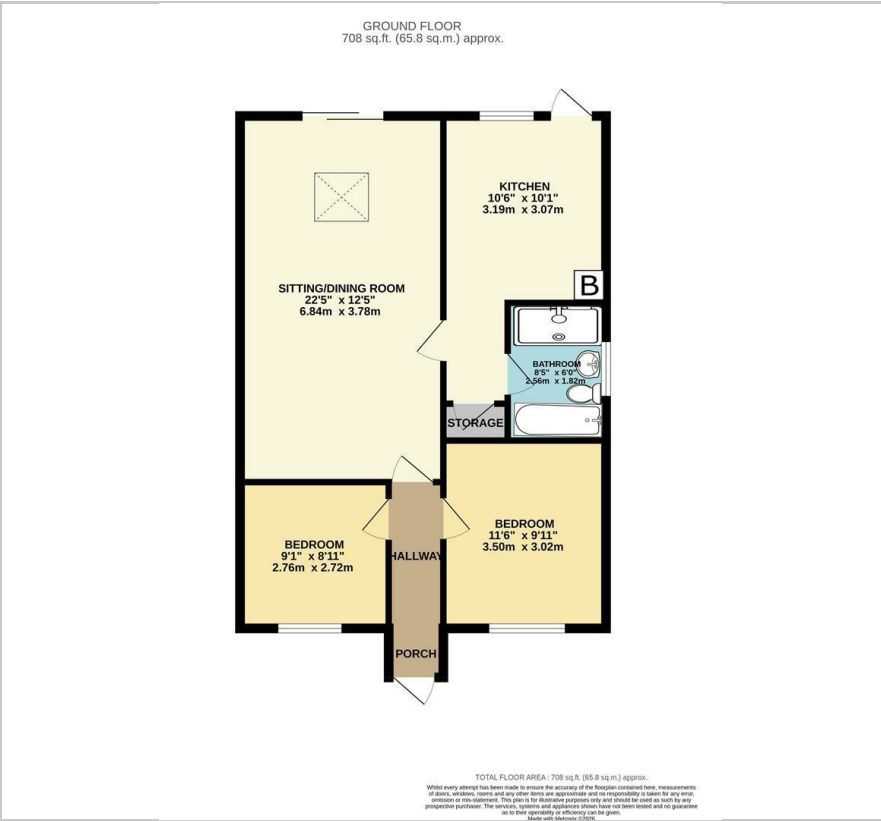

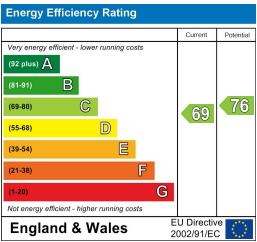
Floor Plan

The property welcomes you through a porch into a central entrance hall which provides access to the two well-proportioned bedrooms, both situated at the front of the property.
