Outside there are two dedicated car parking spaces for the apartment, together with covered cycle racks and an enclosed bin store.

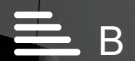

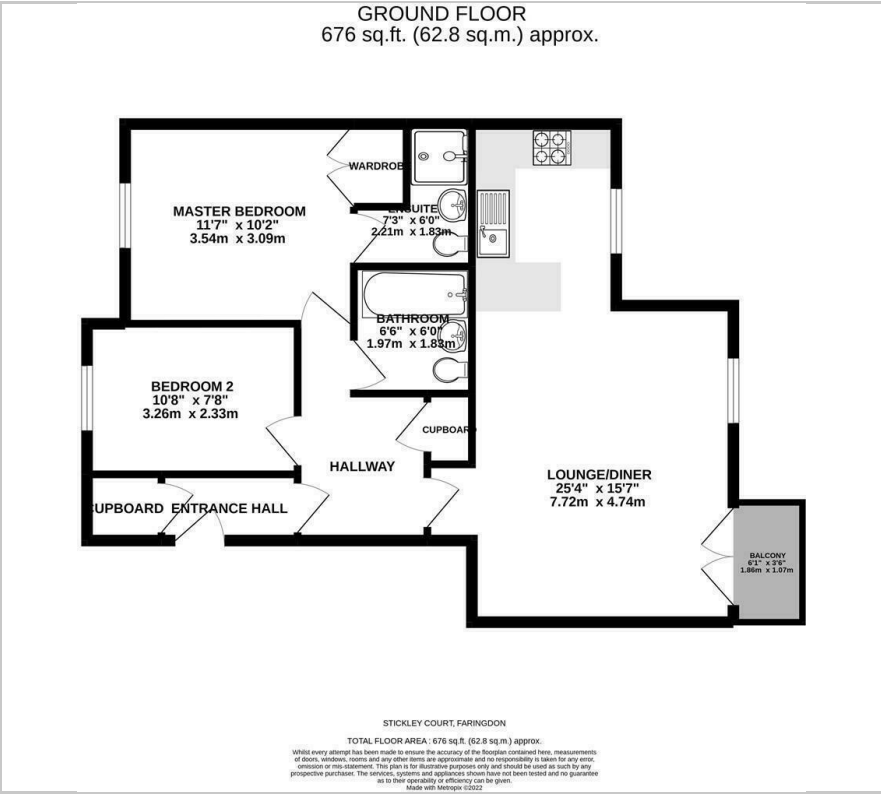

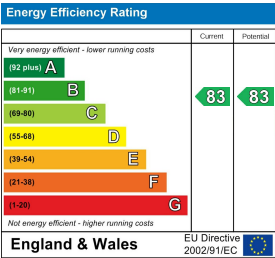
Floor Plan
