Why Showering Before Entering The Pool Matters

A quick shower before entering the pool may seem like a small step, but it plays a big role in keeping our community pool clean, safe, and enjoyable for everyone. When swimmers enter the pool without rinsing off first, they bring in:

- Sweat and body oils
- Sunscreen and lotions
- Dirt and grass
- Cosmetics and hair products
- Bacteria and other contaminants

These substances can quickly affect water quality and force the pool to work harder to stay balanced and sanitized.

They can also contribute to:

- Cloudy water
- Strong chlorine odors
- Algae growth
- Increased chemical usage
- Staining or buildup along the tile line

A simple rinse in the shower before swimming helps reduce contaminants and keeps the pool cleaner for all residents and guests.



Friendly Reminder *Please take a moment to:*

- Shower before entering the pool
- Avoid entering the pool if excessively dirty or sweaty
- Encourage children to rinse off as well
- Reapply sunscreen after swimming as needed

Be Proactive for Hurricane Season: June 1 thru November 30

Now that the hurricane season is upon us, the Board and Management are concerned about your safety and well-being. We feel it is important to be proactive in getting some basic information to you. Of course, as this season progresses and we have specific details relative to incoming storms, we will continue to keep you up to date with the latest information about any anticipated impact we will feel in Tampa Bay Community Association.

Please note that in the case of an approaching hurricane, all employees and staff will be responsible for protecting the common areas of the community and will not be in a position to assist residents with their personal property.

Each resident is responsible for securing their personal belongings and for their personal safety

If the National Hurricane Center issues a Hurricane Warning advisory, the following procedures should be taken to ensure your safety and the safety of others.

1. Remain calm and keep listening to the local news for weather conditions, evacuation routes, & nearest shelter.
 2. Plan how to communicate with family members if you lose power: For example, you can use phone, text, social media
 3. Charge your phone: You'll have a full battery if you lose power.
 4. Consider purchasing a cell phone battery power bank for additional cell phone power.
 5. Bookmark your local government's website: This gives you quick access to storm updates and emergency instructions.
 6. All potted plants, furniture, and other items from your patio must be removed and moved indoors.
 7. Build or restock your emergency preparedness kit: Include a flashlight, batteries, cash, and first aid supplies.
 8. Purchase in advance bottled water, ice, and non-perishable items such as canned food, packaged food, paper, personal products, and manual can opener.
 9. Do not leave pets unattended at the property. There are shelters and kennels that will board your pet in case of evacuation.
 10. Obtain necessary prescriptions and medications.
 11. Keep flashlights and battery-operated radio/TV handy with extra batteries.
 12. Clean and fill the bathtub with water.
 13. Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) will not be working in case of power outage. You'll want to make arrangements for cash needs beforehand.
 14. In the event of power failure, turn off all appliances and keep refrigerator door closed. (Food will stay cool for 24 hours)
 15. Fill your vehicle's gas tank before the storm arrives.
16. Avoid downed power lines and report them to your local electric company as soon as possible.
 17. Take refuge in a small interior room during the storm.
 18. Keep all windows and doors closed through the storm. Do not crack a window or door during the storm. Draw your verticals and drapery materials over the windows to protect from the possibility of shattering glass.
 19. Create an evacuation plan with your family; you may have to leave quickly.
 20. Avoid walking or driving through flood waters. Just 6 inches of moving water can knock you down, and fast-moving water can sweep your vehicle away.



IN THE EVENT THAT OUR COMMUNITY SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN AN EVACUATION AREA, RESIDENTS SHOULD STAY TUNED TO LOCAL NEWS CHANNELS AND COMPLY WITH ALL MANDATORY EVACUATION ORDERS. ANYONE REMAINING ON PROPERTY DURING A MANDATORY EVACUATION DOES SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.

Lastly, we want to extend our appreciation to you for your cooperation. Your safety is our primary concern. Please be safe and make plans that can be implemented quickly in the case of a change in the hurricane's path.
