Upstairs, the story continues.


As you climb the stairs, you can almost hear the echoes. Imagine... Baby gates at the bottom. First steps taken cautiously. The inevitable tumbles and tears soothed at bedtime. Then later, rushed footsteps racing down to greet friends at the door. The dramatic teenage storms up to bedrooms. Doors closing a little harder than necessary. The first floor offers four well-proportioned bedrooms, making this a true four bedroom detached family home in Winnington, not a compromise. The fourth bedroom is currently used as a home office, ideal for modern working patterns, but could easily be a nursery, dressing room or guest bedroom.

Bedrooms two and three sit on opposite sides of the landing yet offer similar space, a small detail, but one that prevents the age-old sibling debate over who gets the bigger room. Both benefit from built-in wardrobes, providing the storage every growing family needs.

The principal bedroom overlooks the south-facing garden once more, filled with natural light and with an abundance of storage in the built in wardrobes. This is your sanctuary. The room where Sunday mornings begin with little feet padding across the landing, climbing in to discuss the final day of the weekend. And later, when the house is finally quiet, it becomes your retreat, a space to exhale after a full day of family life.

An en-suite shower room adds privacy and practicality, while the family bathroom serves the remaining bedrooms with ease. Downstairs, the additional WC ensures guests never need to venture into your private upstairs space, a small but important detail in busy households.



Externally, this home truly sets itself apart within Winnington. Occupying one of the largest plots on the street, it enjoys a south-facing rear garden with no directly overlooking properties to the rear, something increasingly rare on modern developments.

The artificial lawn ensures the space is usable year-round without the worry of muddy footprints trailing back inside after those inevitable Cheshire downpours. The raised patio creates the perfect vantage point.


The area is ideal for outdoor living, with nearby countryside walks, green open spaces and canal-side paths perfect for weekend family walks, running routes or cycling.


