Overall, this is a solid, spacious property in a sought-after area, offering both immediate comfort and future potential.

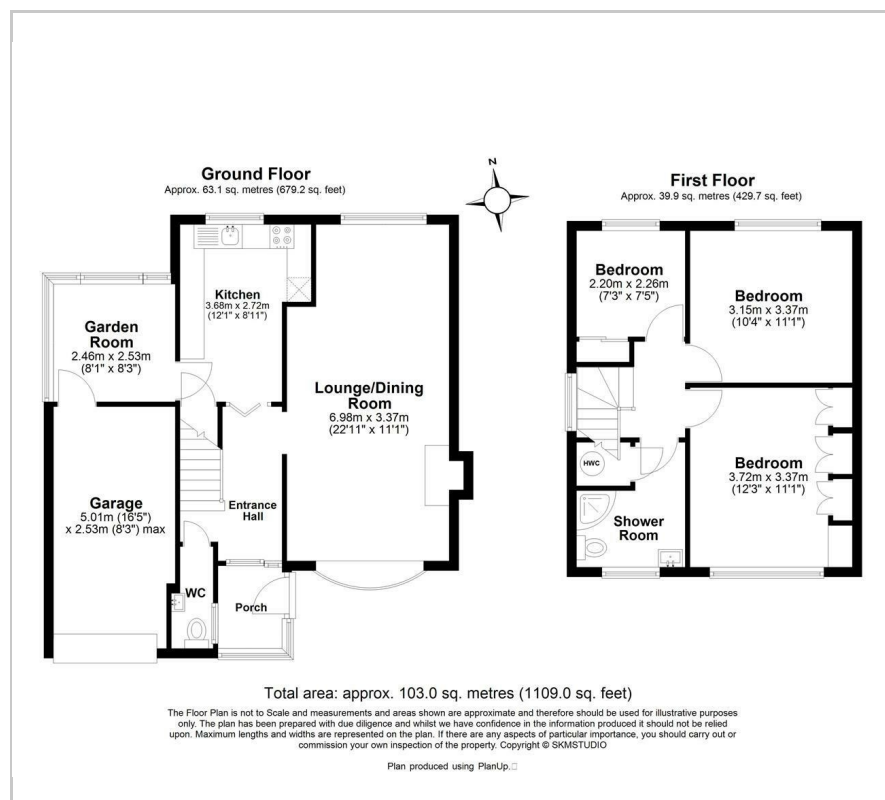

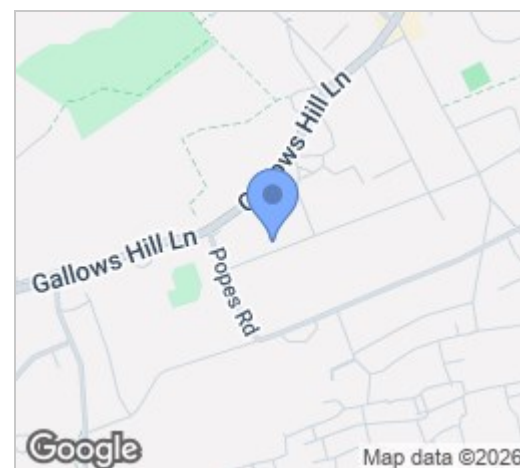

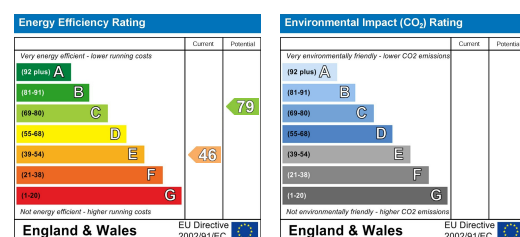
Floor Plan
