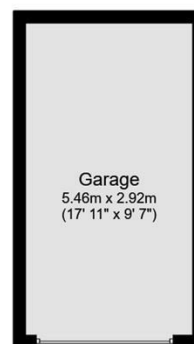
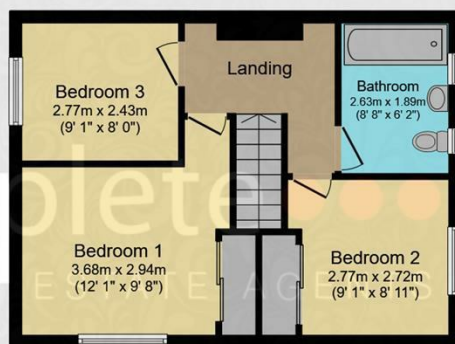
## About Rugby

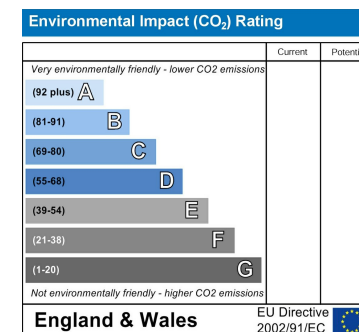
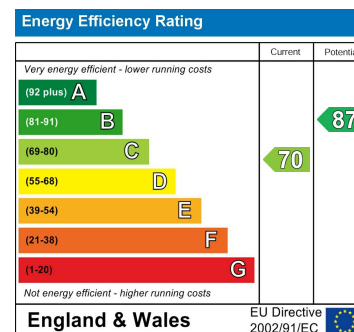
