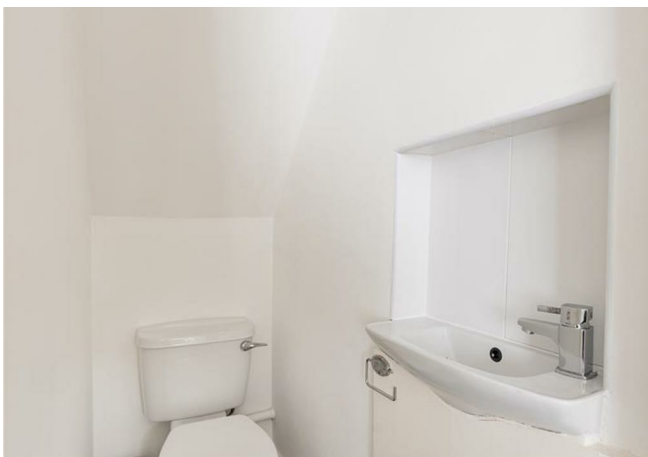

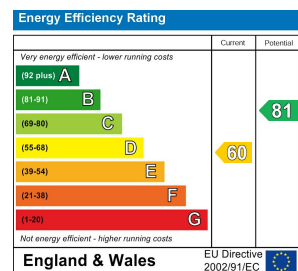
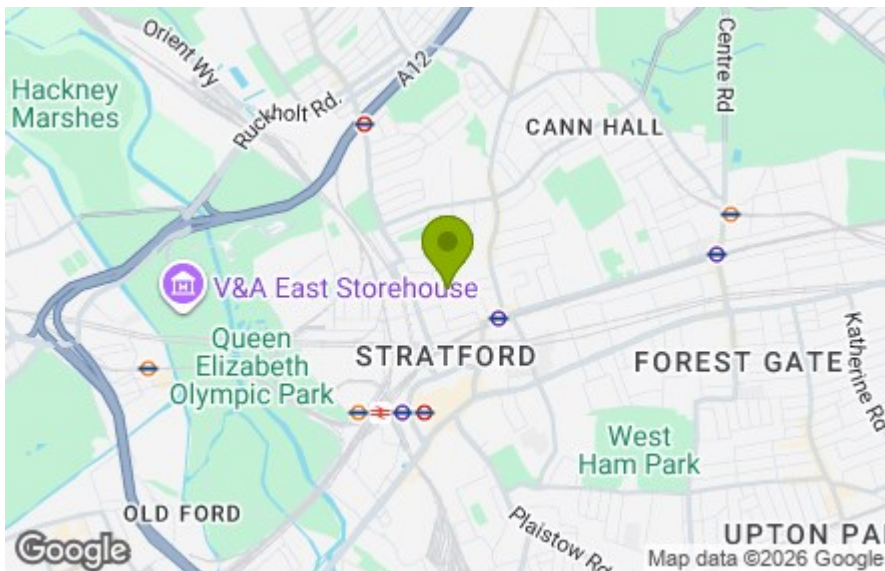


WORD FROM THE EXPERT...
