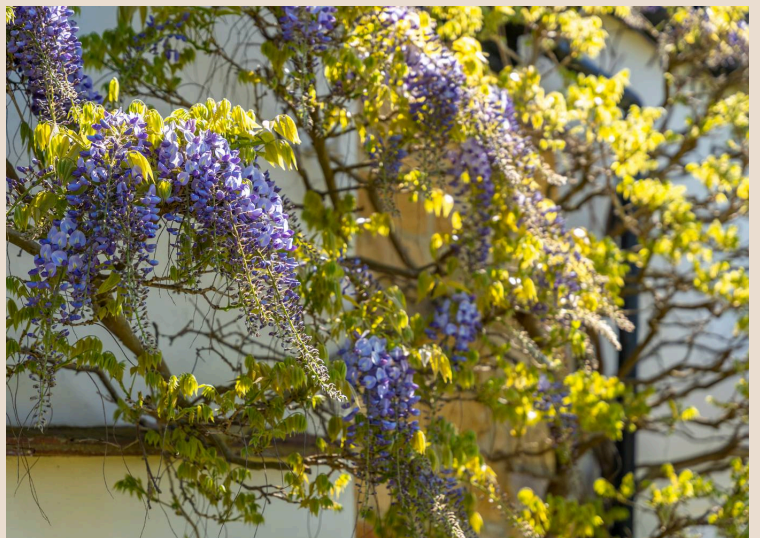
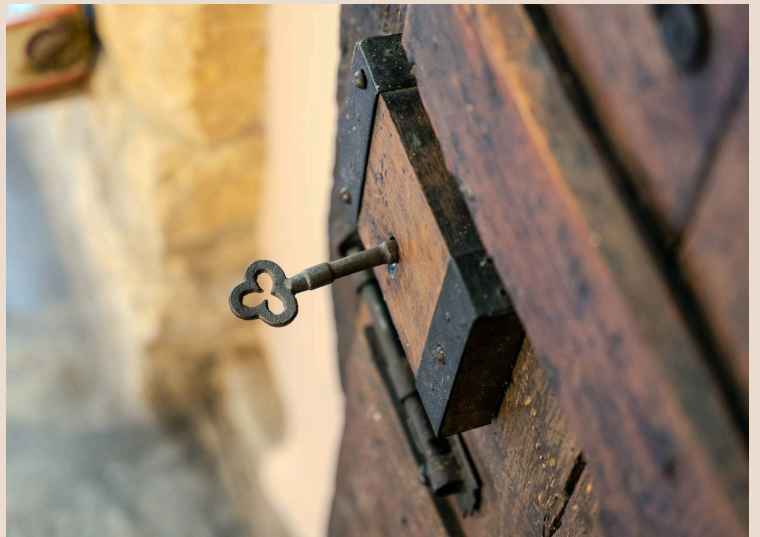




Bankside, Wormington

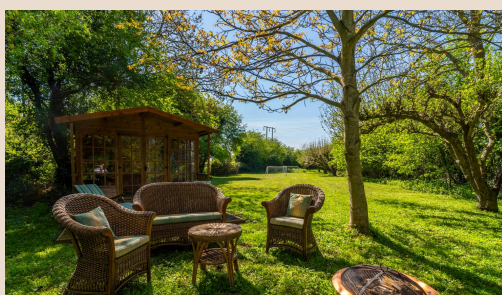
