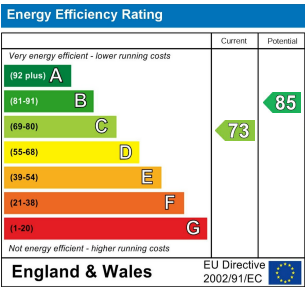
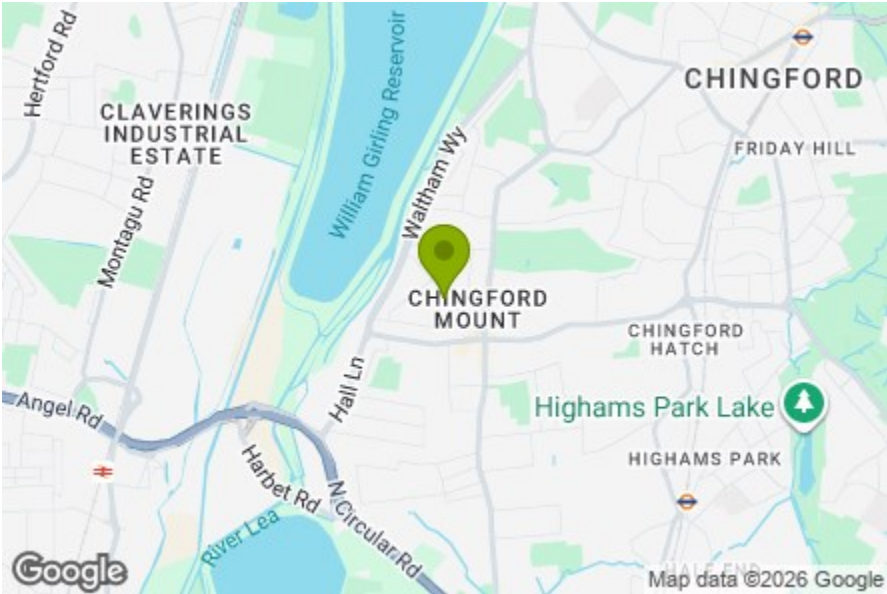

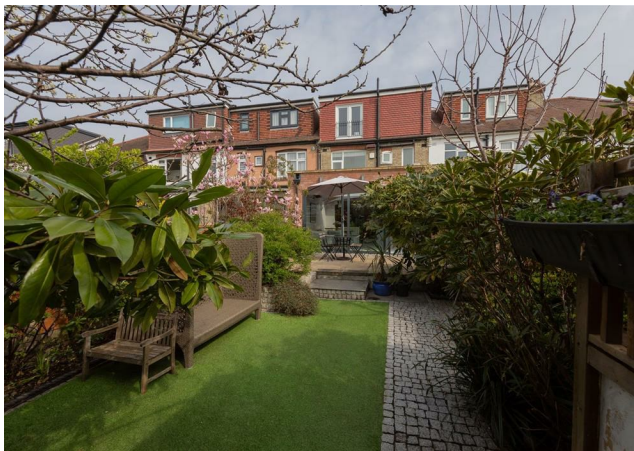

IF YOU LIVED HERE....

The first reception room sits to the front beneath a broad bay window, a calm and welcoming space with plenty of natural light. It is also home to the wood burner, which brings a lovely sense of cosiness in cooler months. Beyond that, the second reception room opens things out beautifully, with generous proportions and garden views, making it a lovely place to gather or unwind.

The kitchen sits neatly alongside, with a practical flow for day to day living, warm timber cabinetry and a skylight overhead drawing in even more natural light. The separate utility room and downstairs WC are the kind of thoughtful details that make busy family life that bit easier.

Across the upper floors, the layout is well judged, with three bedrooms and the family bathroom on the first floor, then a generous top floor bedroom with its own en suite above. From up here, the elevated views are a lovely bonus, adding to the calm and tucked away feel of the room. Altogether you have around 1,435 square feet to settle into, with light filled rooms and a sense that the house has been carefully looked after over time. Air conditioning, underfloor heating and double glazing all add to the day to day comfort, giving the home a quietly considered finish.

Outside, the circa 33 foot south west facing garden is a lovely extension of the living

space, with rear access and a garage garden studio at the far end that could suit all sorts of uses. Whether you need somewhere to work, create, store bikes and tools or simply steal a little time to yourself, it is a genuinely useful addition.

WHAT ELSE?

- Chingford Mount is a short walk away for shops, supermarkets and cafés, with a handful of well-loved local spots for a relaxed coffee or bite to eat. A little further afield, Station Road in Chingford offers a broader mix, including Gina's, a new neighbourhood favourite known for its Italian menu and ties to celebrity chef patronage.

- When you want to head out, both Odeon Luxe Lee Valley and Queen Elizabeth's Hunting Lodge on the edge of Epping Forest are around ten minutes away by car.

- Parents will be pleased to know there are plenty of nearby primary and secondary schools rated Good or Outstanding.
