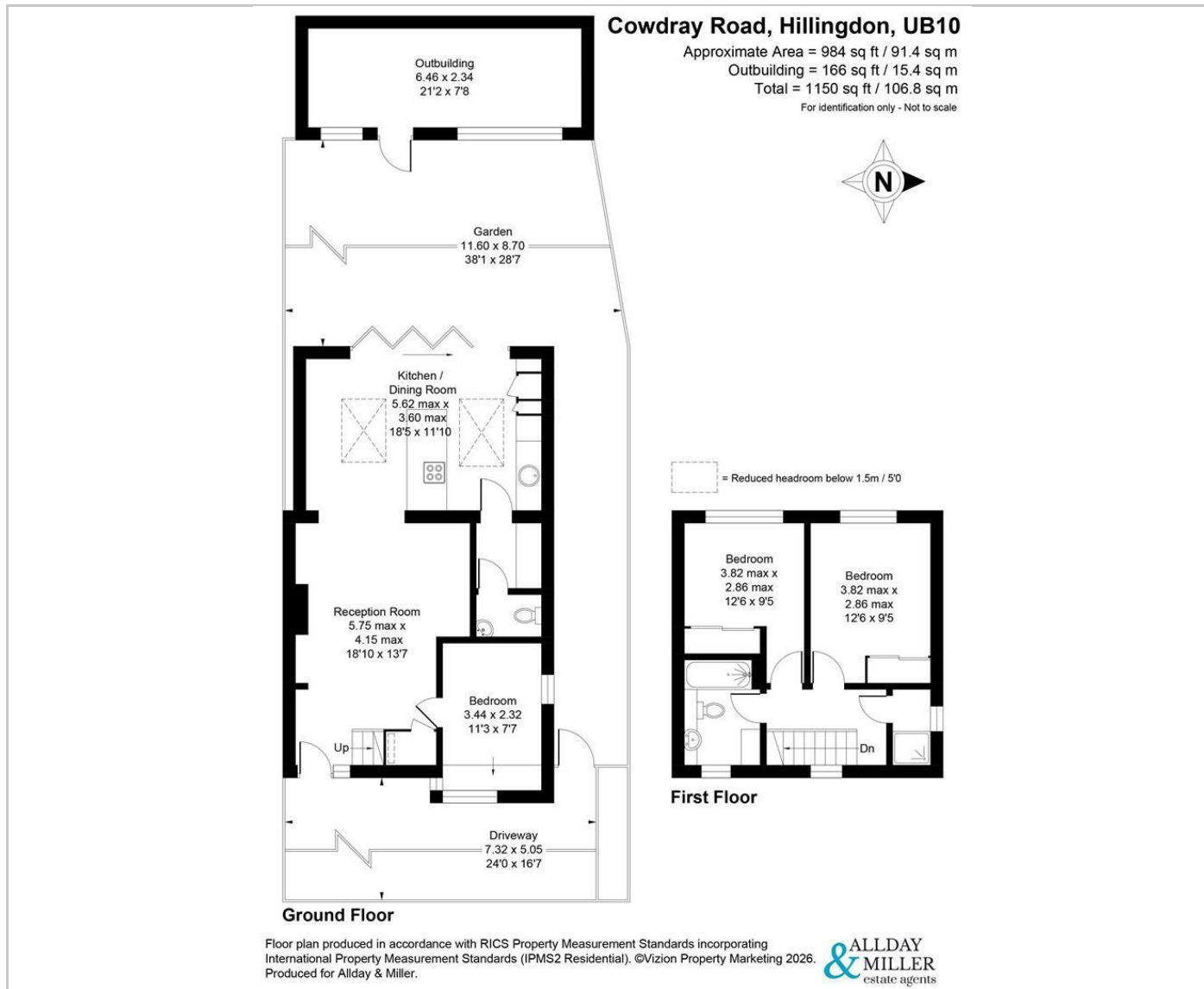

Situation

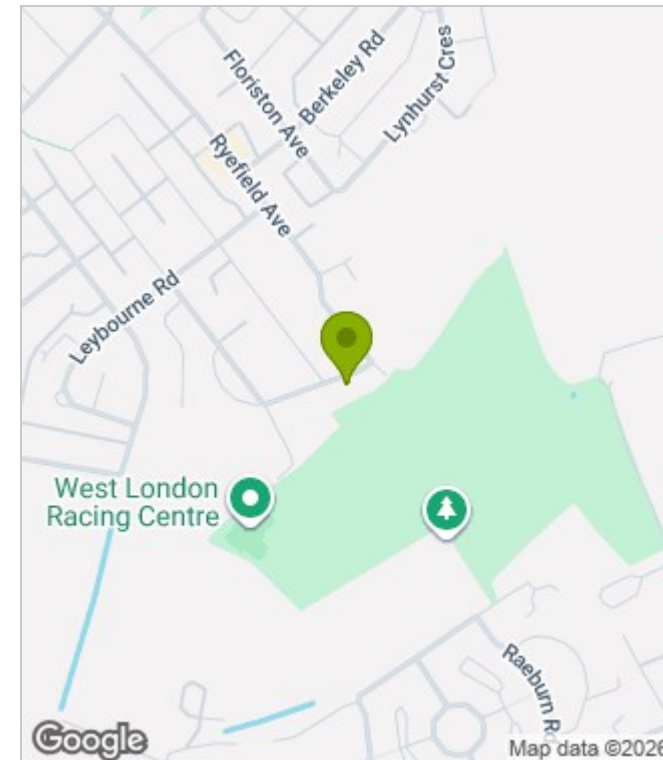

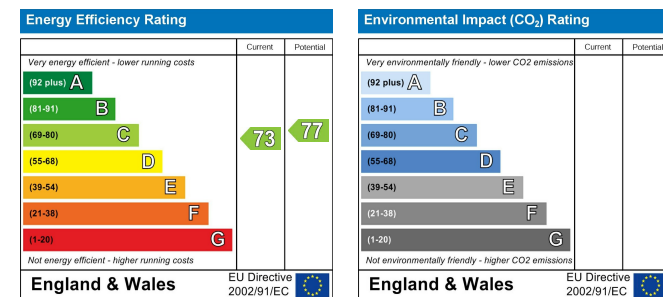
Floor Plans
