A Grade II listed, four-storey home with three to four bedrooms, two bathrooms, a separate WC, a reception room, and parking. Completed in 1846, Keystone Crescent is celebrated as the smallest crescent in Europe. The houses are uniform in design, featuring round-arched doorways, Welsh slate roofs, and a distinctive stucco band at second-storey level.




**First Floor**
