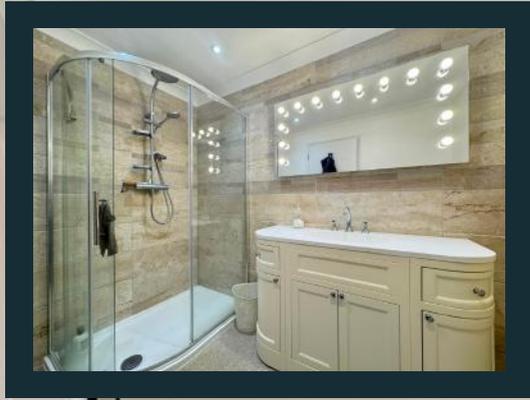

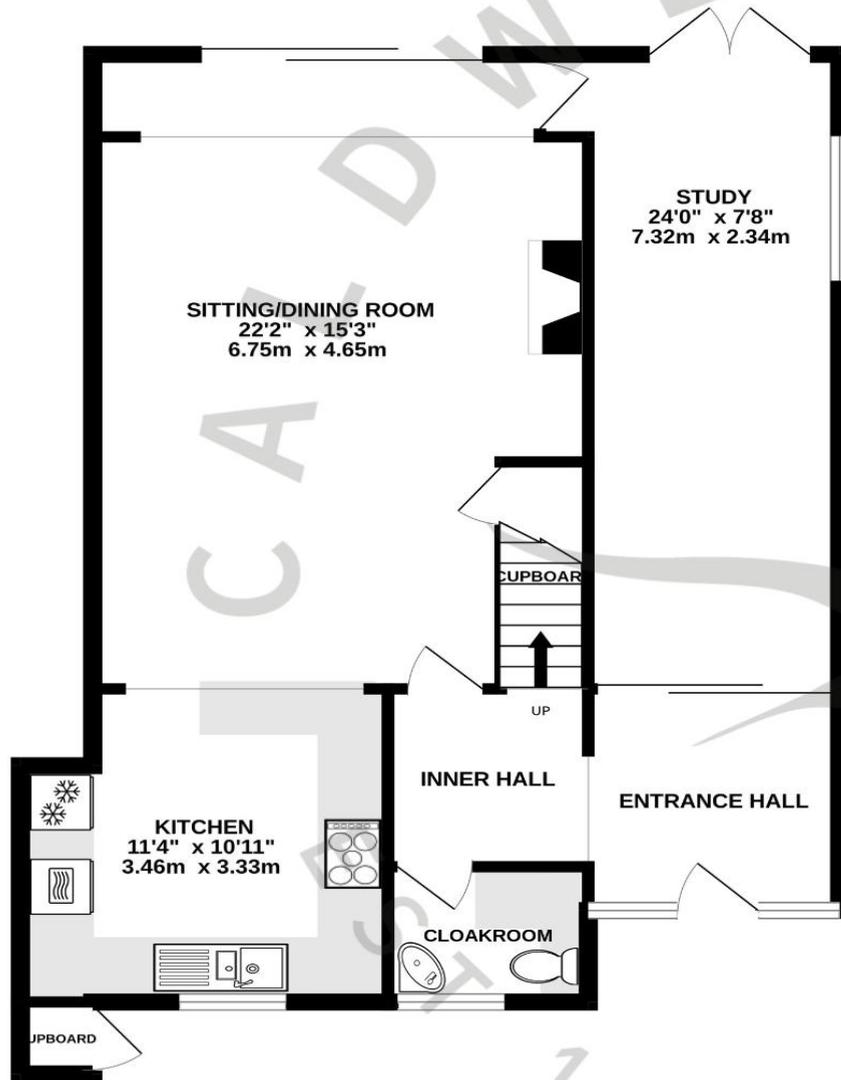


Meet me in the garden...

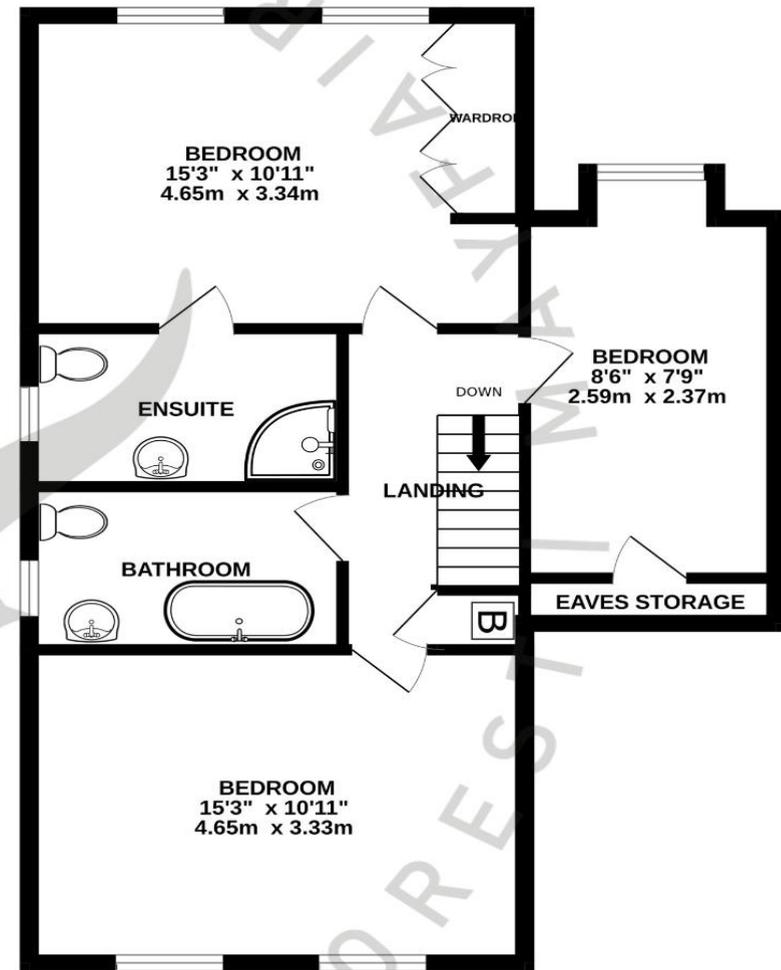
