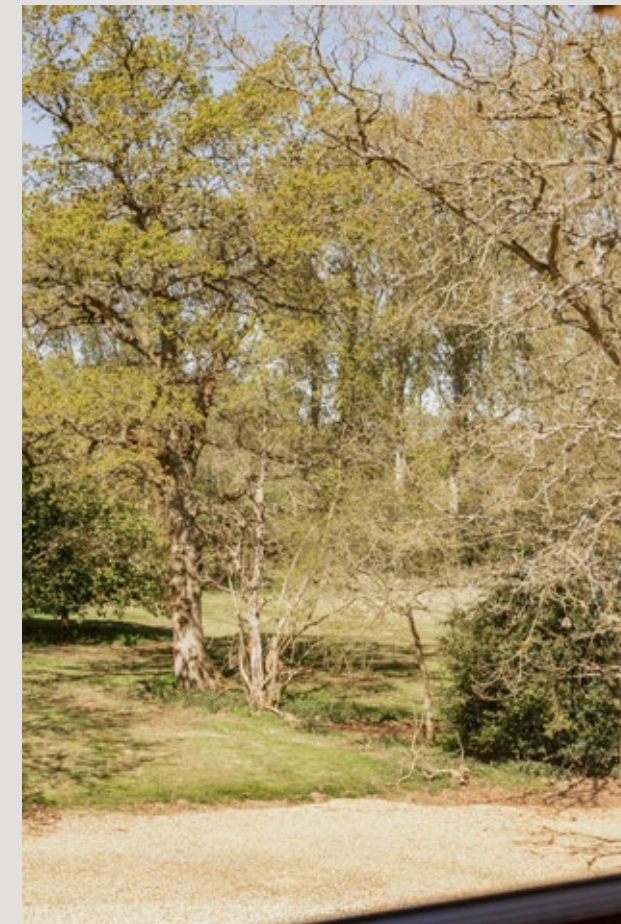

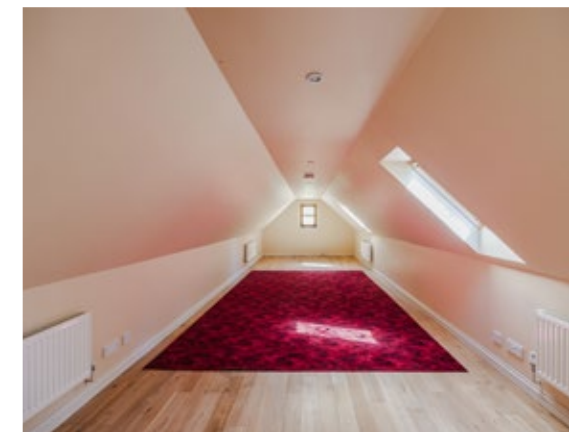

Located within the North Norfolk countryside, the village of Corpusty offers a peaceful rural setting with a strong sense of community, while remaining well connected to nearby towns and the coast. Village life centres around St Peter's Church, Corpusty, a historic landmark that reflects the area's heritage. The village features a mix of traditional brick and flint homes alongside more contemporary properties, all set within a picturesque landscape.
