SITUATION

Rousden Farm sits beautifully on the fringe of the idyllic village of North Cowton, overlooking open countryside. The village has the benefit of an active community with a village hall, primary school, a public house serving meals and a bus route running through.

It is within easy access to the desirable market towns of Richmond, Darlington and Northallerton which offer a wide range of shops, amenities and facilities, including a mainline station with a regular service to London Kings Cross. The property is also in close proximity to both the A1(M) and the A19, bringing larger centres such as Teesside, Harrogate and Leeds within reasonable commuting distance. Teesside International Airport is 25 minutes' drive approximately.

DESCRIPTION

Rousden Farm comprises a traditional detached character property which stands well on the edge of North Cowton in a south facing position. The property has been very well maintained with many architectural features including bespoke arched oak windows and oak external doors. It is complemented by a range of useful outbuildings, stabling and ménage together with 8 acres of land making it an ideal equestrian property.

Rousden Farm is entered into a welcoming reception hall from where the rooms lead off from. The accommodation is on one level and comprises of a large living room with a log burning stove set within a Victorian cast iron surround, and a dining area with windows on three aspects making it lovely and light. There is a separate sitting room with a multi-fuel stove within a marble surround.

The large kitchen diner features an extensive range of fitted oak wall and base units which are complemented by granite worktops and a Rangemaster cooker. There is an integrated washing machine, tumble dryer, dishwasher and freezer together with freestanding American style fridge freezer. There are windows to three aspects and a door leading out to the rear. Usefully, there is also a loft access which provides access to a storage space.

The property has a total of four bedrooms which are all well-proportioned and enjoy a pleasant outlook. Two of the bedrooms have the benefit of ensuite bath/shower rooms and there is a family bathroom with WC, basin, shower cubicle and jacuzzi bath.

Externally the property is complemented by immaculately presented and good-sized gardens which wrap around the property and are laid to lawn with a mix

of established fruit trees and orchard. There is also a large raised vegetable garden. The land is split into 3 useful paddocks and there is a detached stable block with four stable boxes. There is also a brick built agricultural building with concrete floor providing excellent hay storage or garage workshop and a ménage making the property very suitable for those with equine interests. It will also appeal to those looking for a small holding or lifestyle change.

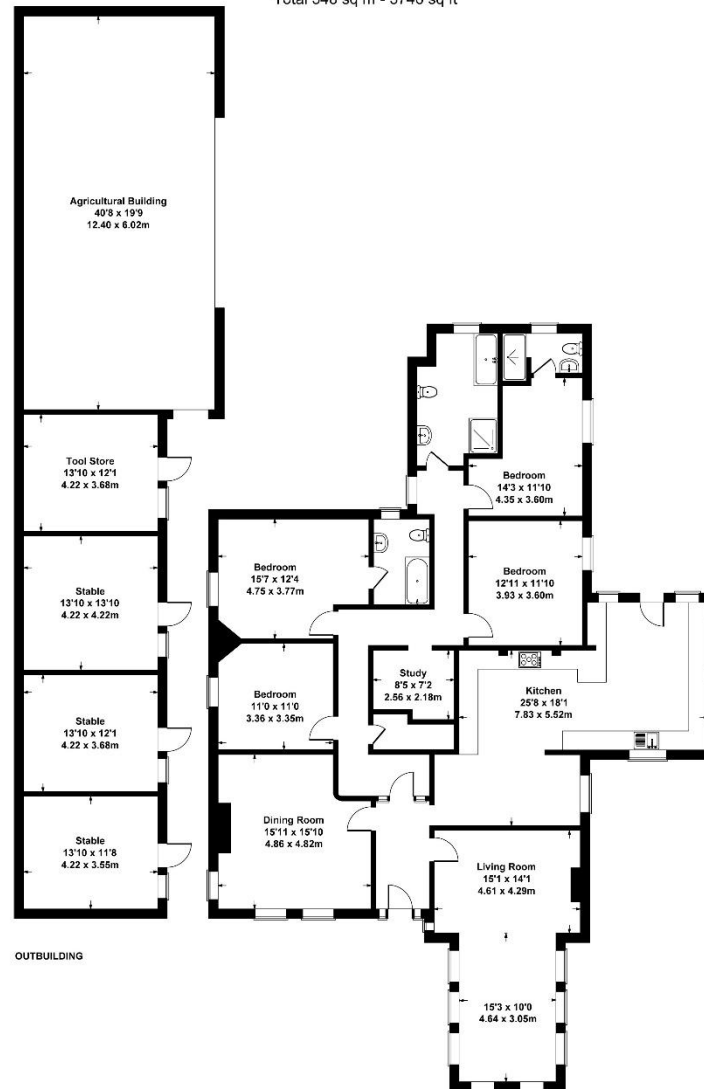

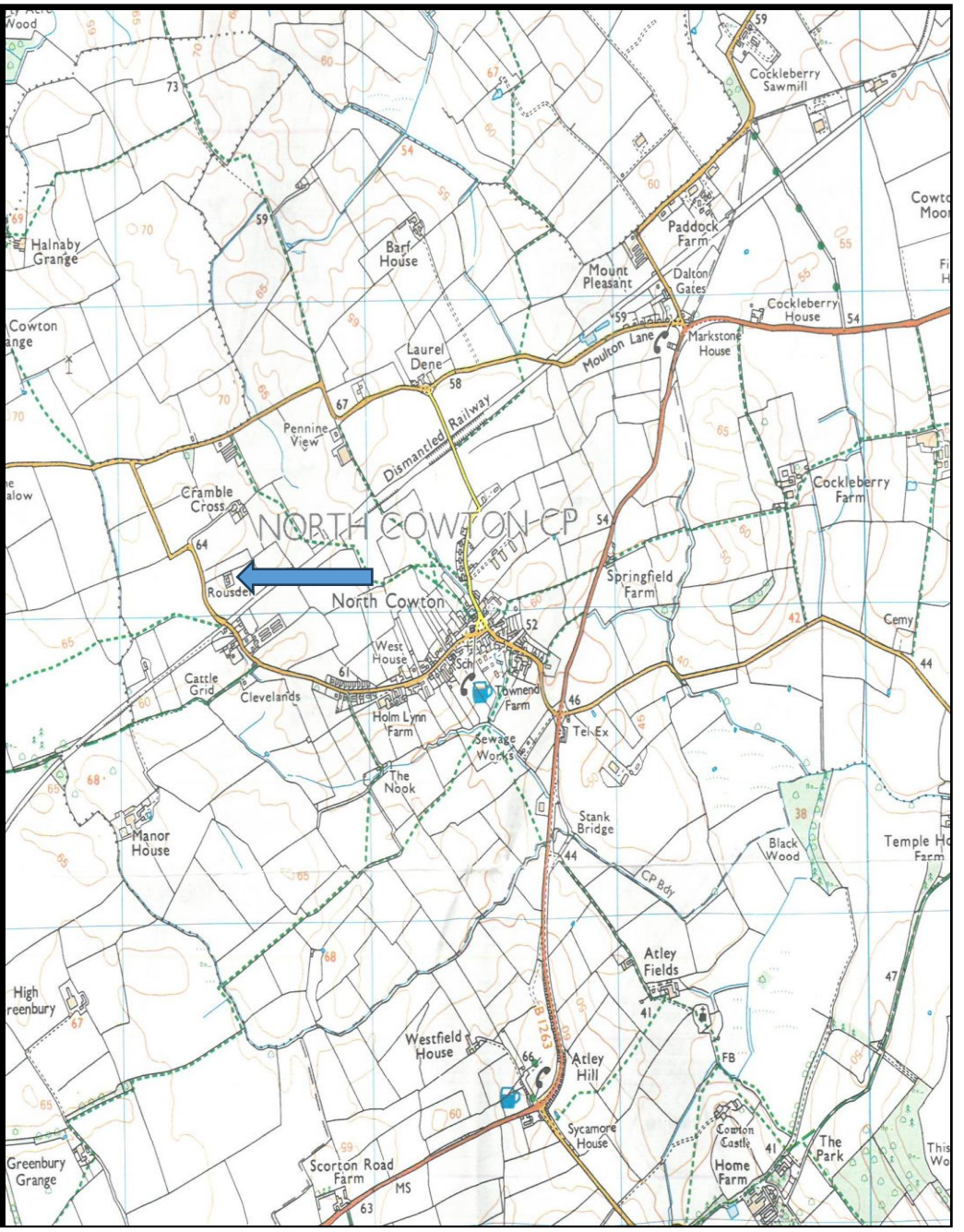

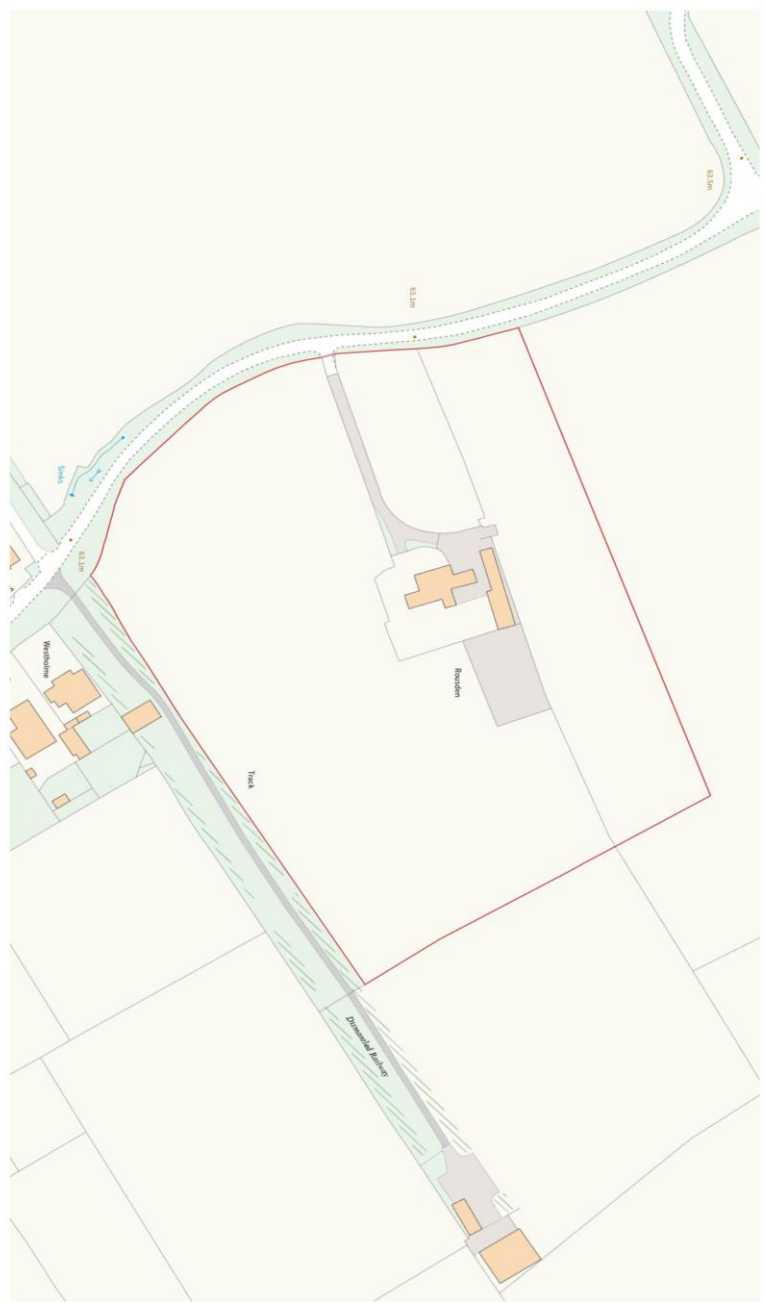
