

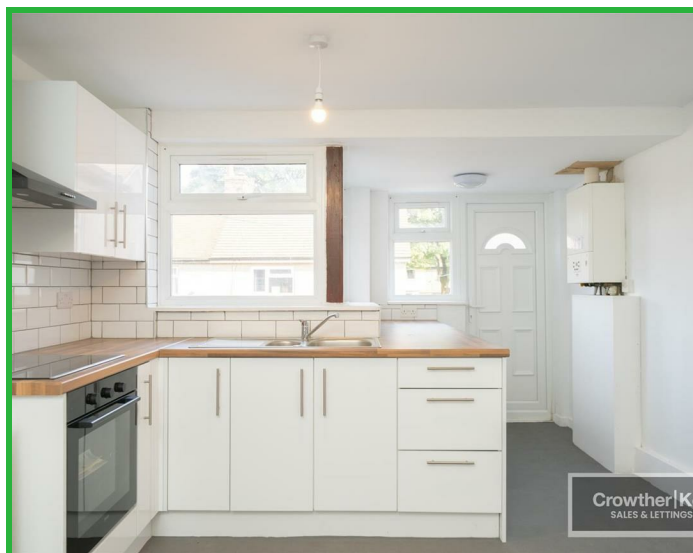

Location

The property occupies a convenient and central position on Bennett Street, a popular residential road within the Buxton Central area, linking Byron Street and Dale Road. Buxton is the celebrated Georgian and Victorian spa town set high in the Derbyshire hills and widely regarded as the gateway to the Peak District National Park, and the town centre is within easy walking distance — approximately half a mile — offering an excellent range of independent retailers, High Street names, cafés and restaurants around the pedestrianised Spring Gardens, together with the renowned Opera House and the 23-acre Pavilion Gardens. Buxton Infant School is only a few hundred yards away, while Buxton railway station, offering regular direct services to Manchester Piccadilly, is around half a mile distant, and the open countryside of the Peak District is close at hand.

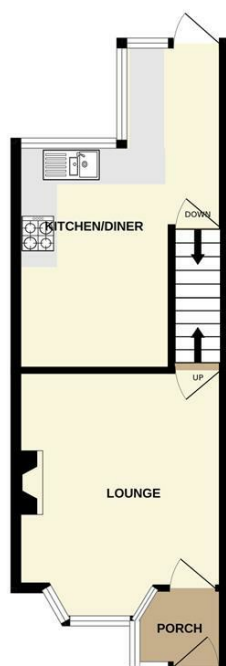
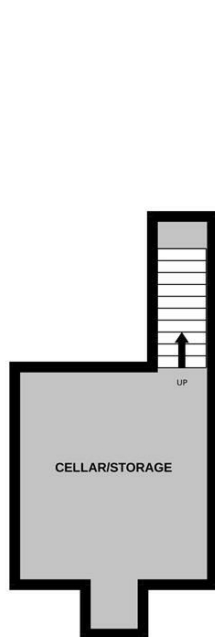
