LongDescription

This property offers generous accommodation and would ideally suit a first time buyer or young family who are keen to stamp their own mark on the accommodation. The house has been extended to the side to provide very useful extra living space, including a bedroom, utility room and cloakroom. In the past the utility room was used as an en suite shower room and could be reverted back, if required, perhaps for an elderly relative or older child.

The kitchen is fitted in a contemporary, light grey style, with integral ovens, a ceramic hob with extractor hood over and space for appliances and has room for a dining table and chairs. A door gives access to the rear garden.

Upstairs, there are two large double bedrooms and a very small cot room, home office or store. The shower room is currently fitted as a wet room for an elderly person and was originally a separate WC and bathroom. Many would wish to update this with a new suite and block off one of the doorways, which led to the original bathroom.

Outside, there is a large front lawn garden, with path to the front door and leading around to the right of the house and enclosed, rear garden. A gate leads to a rear path, giving access to the residents' communal car park.

Services: Mains water, electricity and drainage.

1) Having recently suffered from a water leak, the insurance has funded repairs including new ceilings and decoration, and the remainder just needs some updating, including conversion of the wetroom to a bath or shower room and new carpets or flooring throughout.

Willand has a good range of local amenities, including a popular primary school, mini markets, a post office/shop, service station, pub and village hall. The village now lies in the catchment area for Uffculme School, offering secondary education, Ofsted rated 'Outstanding' or 'Good' in all areas.

Willand lies within easy reach of the more extensive services of Cullompton and Tiverton and Junctions 27 and 28 of the M5 motorway can be quickly accessed, both within three miles.

Regular bus services also pass through Willand and there are trains from the nearby Tiverton Parkway station (London Paddington in around 2 hours).

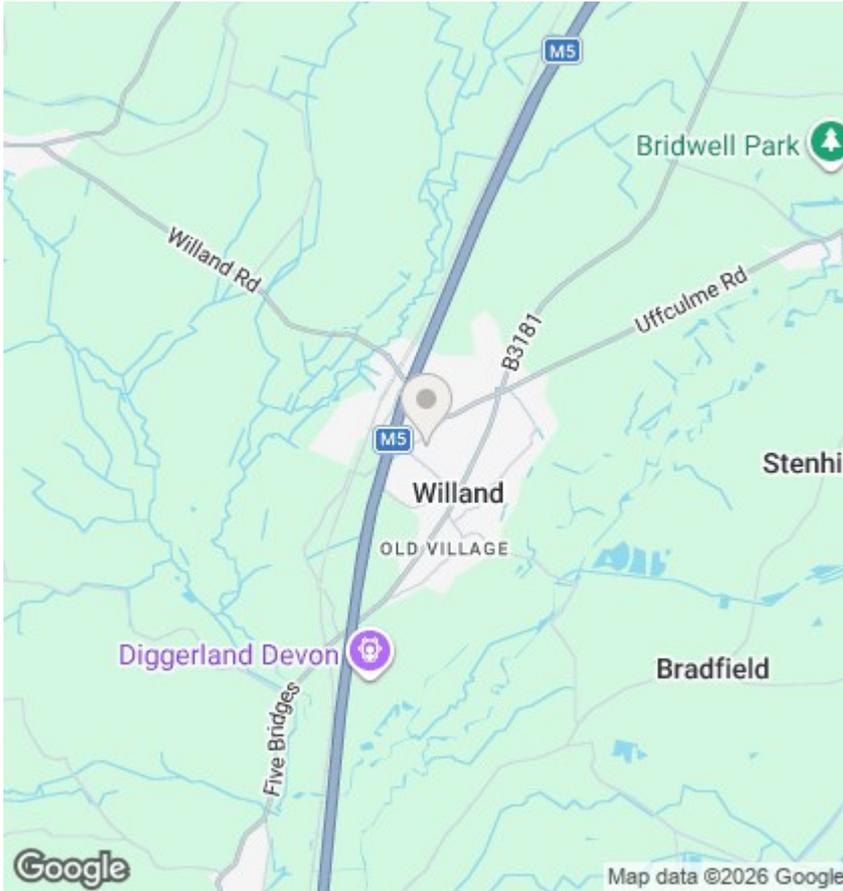
