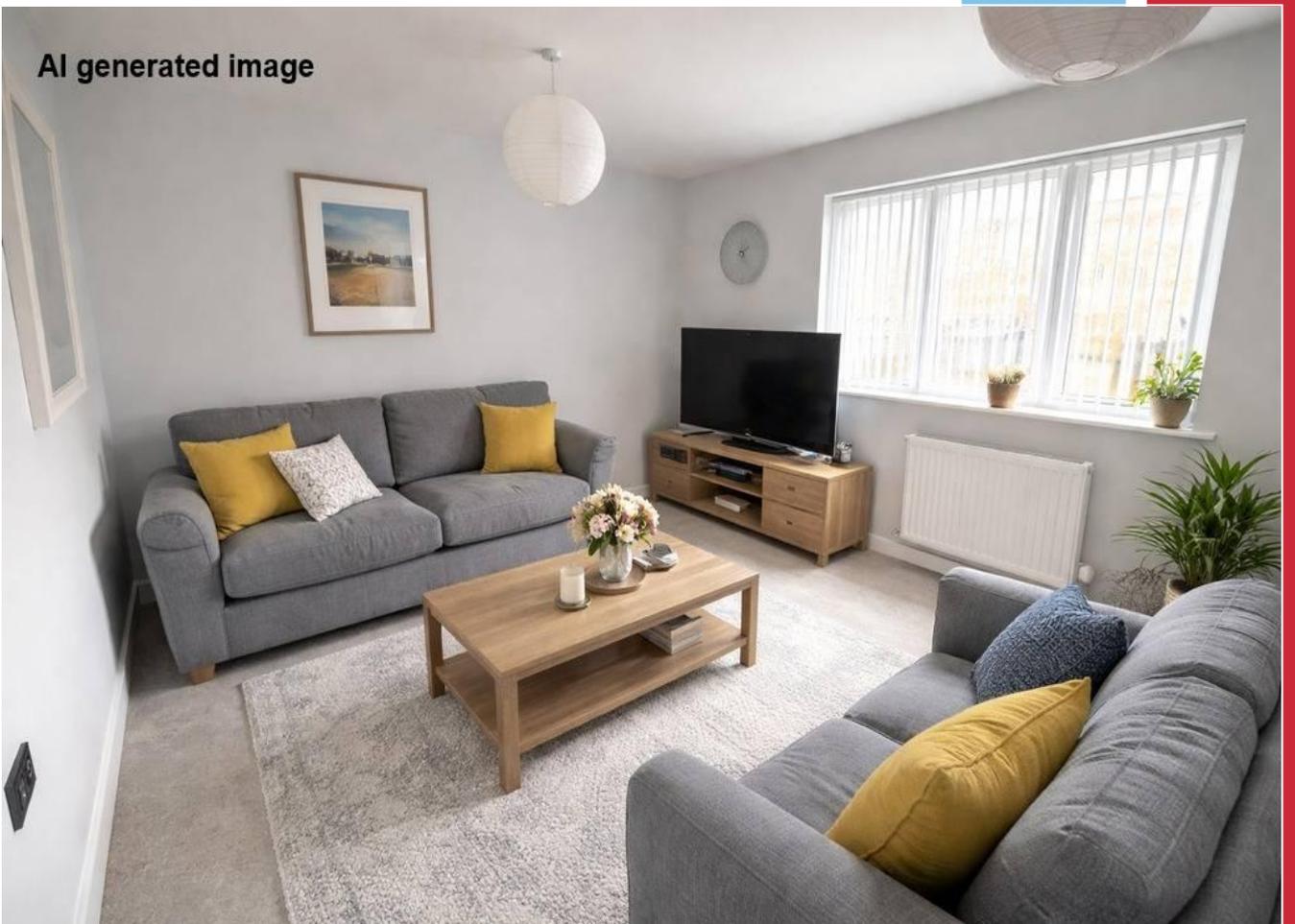

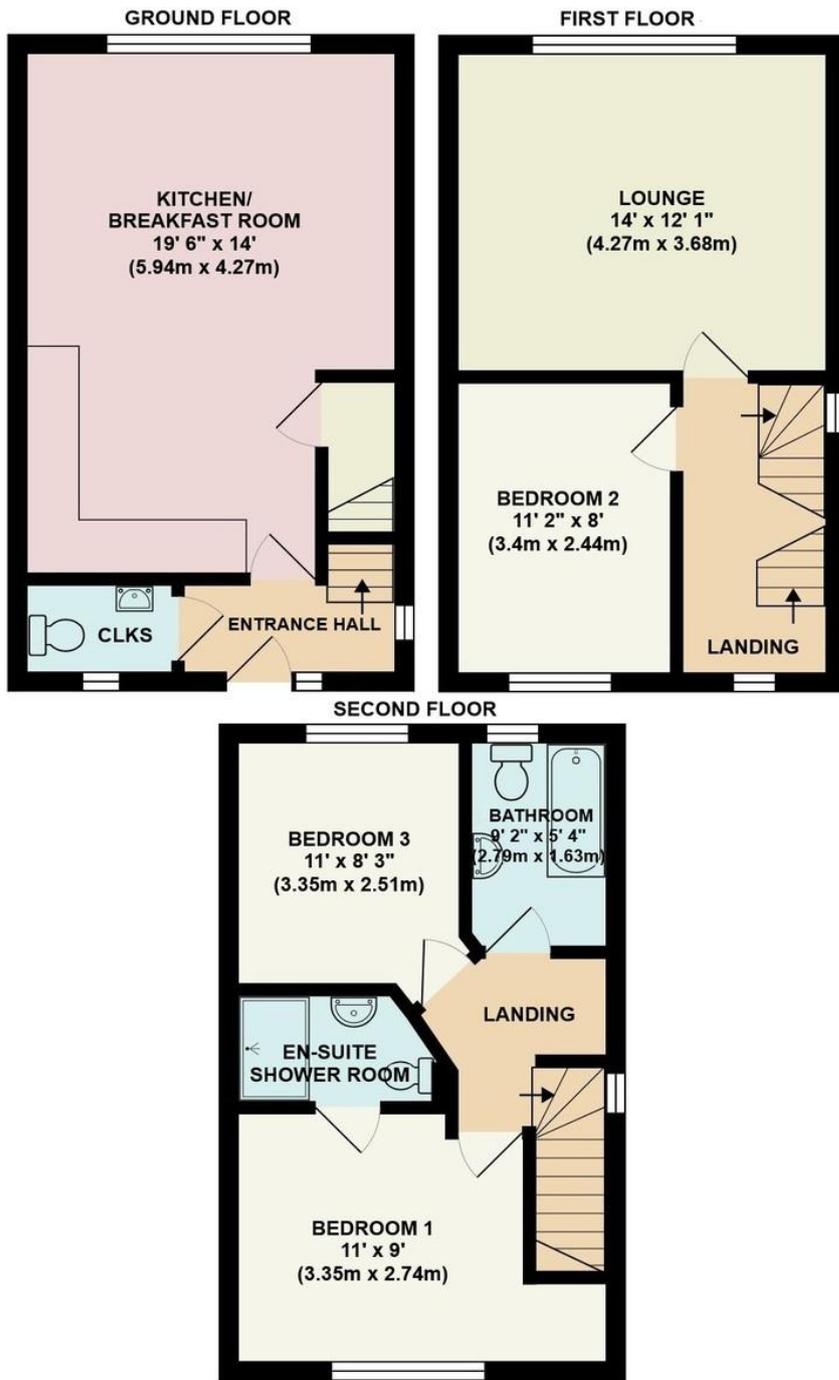

The Property

Upon entering there is a cloakroom to the side and a door leads through to the kitchen/breakfast room, which is currently being used as a reception area. There is great space here with the kitchen area benefiting from integrated appliances, high gloss units, quartz worktops and throughout the ground floor there is Karndean flooring. There is an understairs storage cupboard and to the rear French style double glazed doors lead out on to the patio and garden. On the first floor you will find the lounge, currently being used as an extra bedroom and bedroom two. Stairs then lead up to the second floor and the accommodation here comprises the master bedroom with an en-suite shower room, bedroom three and a

generous size family bathroom. Outside the front door of this private development there are two allocated off road parking spaces and the courtyard style rear garden consists of a patio area and a section laid with artificial grass for ease of maintenance.

It is a short walk to the Lighthouse – Poole Centre of the Arts, providing live performances, film and visual art along with Poole Park, Poole town centre and the mainline railway to London Waterloo. The slipway at Baiter Park, Whitecliff Park, Poole Quay and old town Poole are also within easy reach. We feel the house would suit not only an 'owner occupier' but a buy to let or for the use as a second home.
