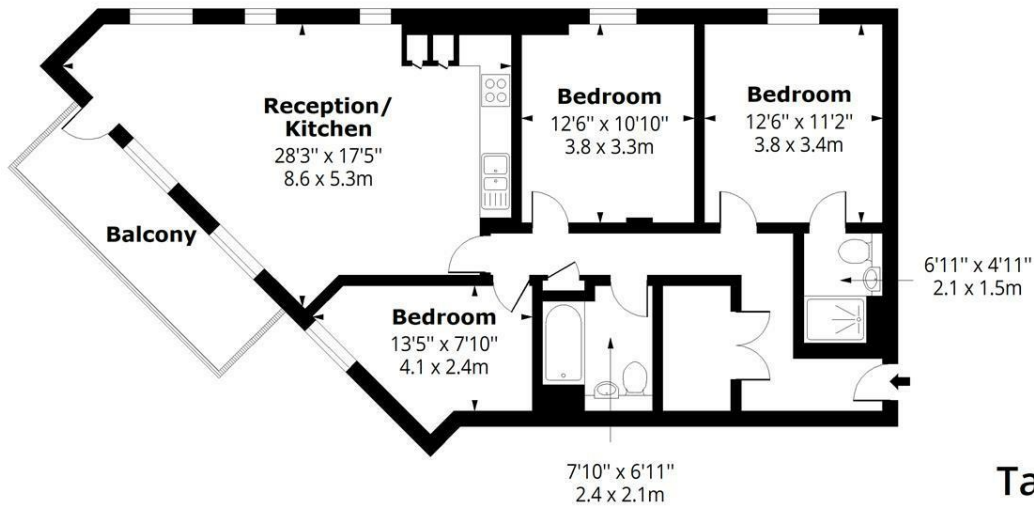
A spacious three-bedroom flat located on the top floor of Taylor House, offering well-proportioned accommodation and a practical layout suitable for a range of buyers or tenants.
