About the area

Ringshall enjoys an idyllic setting on the edge of the charming village of Little Gaddesden, nestled within the heart of the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Surrounded by the magnificent National Trust Ashridge Estate and its enchanting beechwood forests, the location offers a rare blend of natural tranquillity and everyday convenience.

Little Gaddesden itself is a quintessential English village, rich in character and community spirit. Set amidst approximately 5,000 acres of protected woodland, the area provides a paradise for outdoor enthusiasts, with an abundance of scenic walking, cycling and riding routes along public footpaths and bridleways. The village is home to a welcoming shop and Post Office, a traditional country pub, a historic church, and an outstanding primary school. Recreational opportunities abound, with a thriving cricket and tennis club and the prestigious Ashridge Golf Club — widely regarded as one of the finest championship courses in the country.

For more extensive amenities, the vibrant market towns of Berkhamsted (approximately 5 miles) and Tring (around 7 miles) offer a fantastic array of restaurants, bistros, boutiques, and independent retailers, as well as supermarkets including Waitrose, M&S Food Hall, and Tesco. Berkhamsted also boasts the iconic art deco Rex Cinema — a much-loved local landmark.

The area is well served by both state and independent schools, with excellent senior education options in Berkhamsted, Harpenden, Markyate, St Albans, and Hemel Hempstead.

Commuters will appreciate the superb transport links: direct access to the A41 connects easily with the M25 and M1, while Berkhamsted Station offers fast and frequent rail services to London Euston in as little as 32 minutes.


