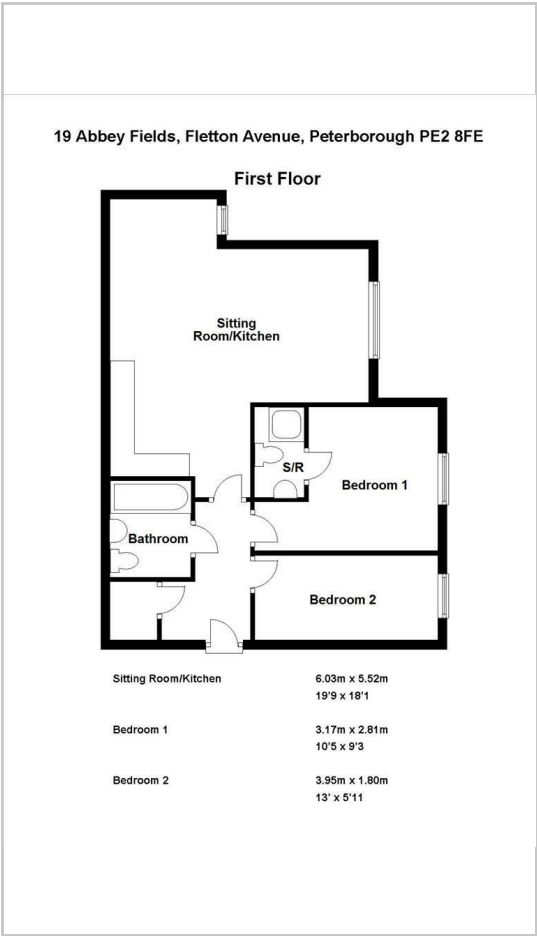

Area Map



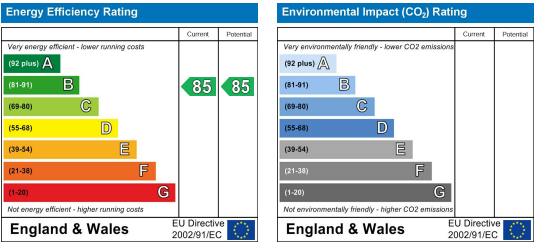
Floor Plans
