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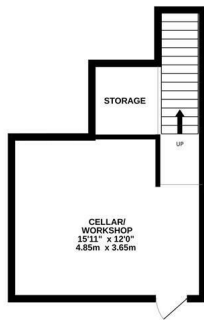
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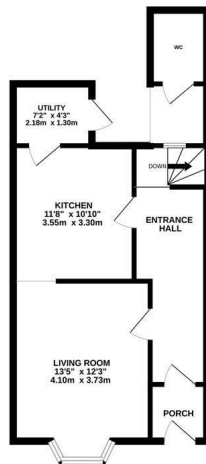
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Guide Price £400,000 - £450,000 A charming and characterful FOUR STOREY HOUSE nestled within a QUIET TWITTEN in the heart of Hastings Old Town. It benefits from PICTURESQUE ROOFTOP AND SEA VIEWS and is located within easy walking distance of the beach, independent shops, antique stores, restaurants and traditional pubs. The West Hill and Hastings Town centre are also within easy reach. Originally constructed in 1863 the EARLY VICTORIAN ACCOMMODATION retains a wealth of original features including exposed floorboards, fireplaces and sash windows. You enter on the ground floor which is arranged as a bay fronted living room with a feature fireplace, this leads through to the kitchen and scullery positioned at the rear of the property. The kitchen is fitted with an ORIGINAL COAL FIRED RAYBURN STOVE and there is also gas central heating. The small courtyard garden provides an idyllic spot to dine al-fresco and there is an outside w/c. On the first floor there is a shower room, a double bedroom and a second reception room with a MARBLE FIREPLACE and bay window framing an attractive outlook, this could be

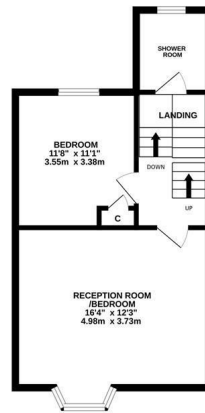

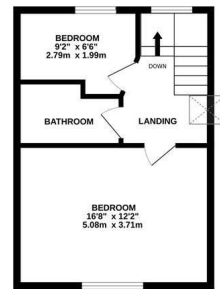
