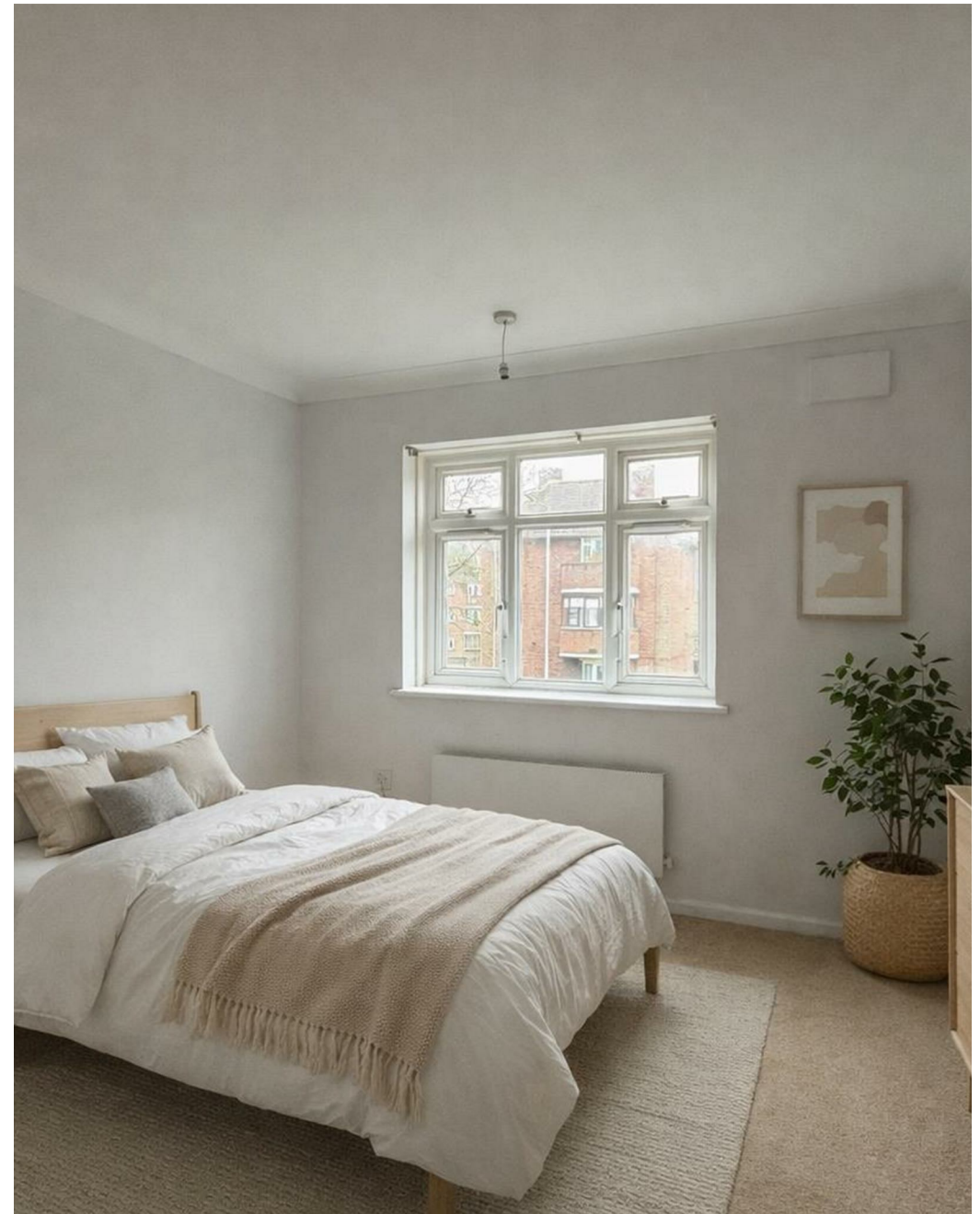

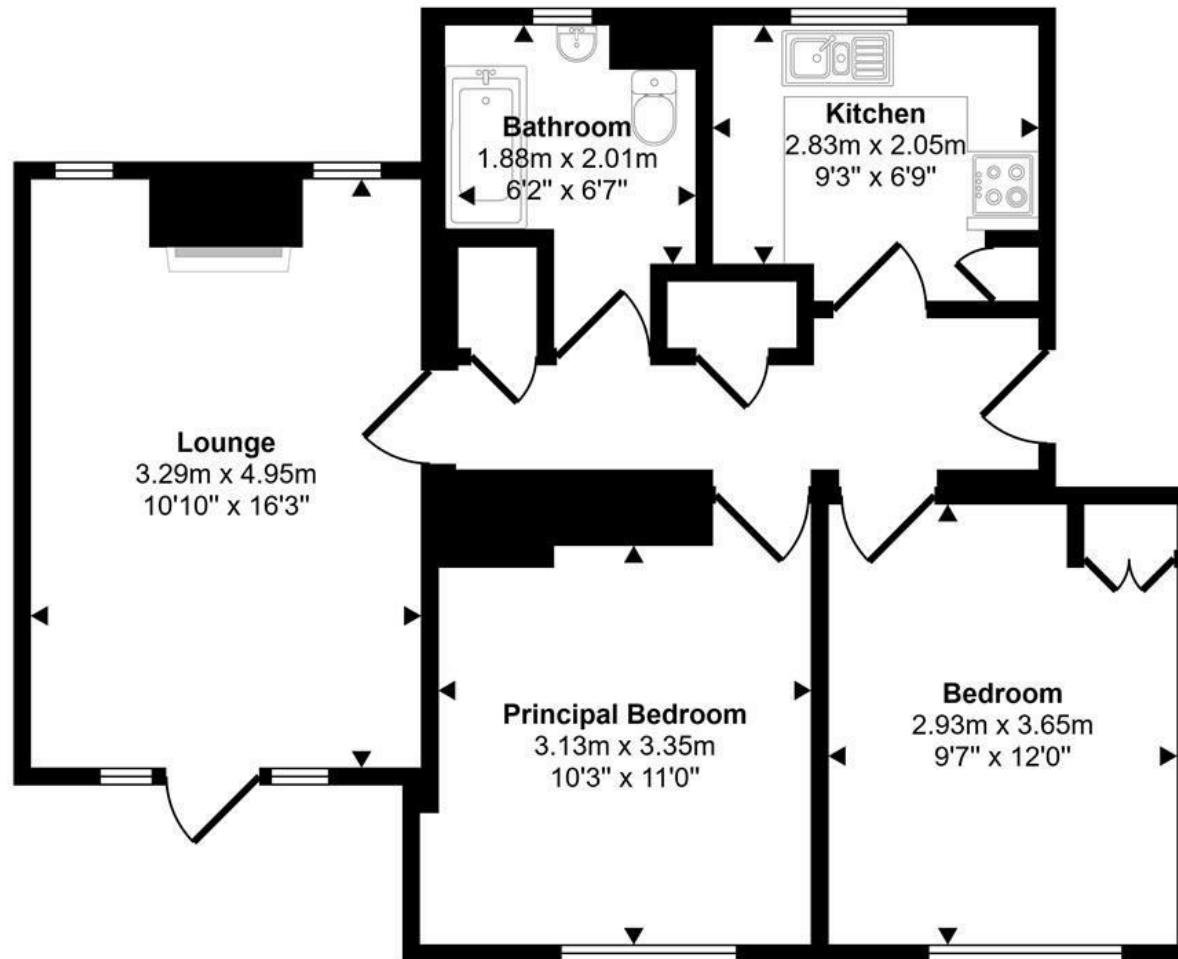
On street permit parking is available.
