Fine proportions, period charm and ideal for the town's amenities. 'Sheridan House' is a delightful Grade II Listed home set in the very heart of Devizes town centre, offered with no onward chain. Long Street is one of the most prestigious streets in historic Devizes, with an array of beautiful individual period homes that lie just a stone's throw from the Market Place.

This handsome period property is bigger than it first appears (over 2000 sqft in fact including the useful basement). Upon entering the house you are welcomed by a tiled entrance lobby that opens through to a drawing room with a high ceiling and an exposed brick fireplace with painted wooden surround (scope for an open fire). An inner hall, with downstairs cloakroom, has stairs up to the first floor and stairs down to a converted cellar- used previously as a workshop and study area. There is a separate dining room with built-in storage cupboards and a modern galley kitchen with tiled flooring and a 'Range' style oven and door opening to the private courtyard garden. On the first floor a generous elegant living room with sash windows and ornate fireplace could be alternatively used as the main bedroom (depending on the number of bedrooms required). There is a further bedroom with ample storage, a contemporary shower room with a floor to ceiling window, and a quirky enclosed study area with a skylight. On the top floor are two large double bedrooms, both benefitting from fitted wardrobes, and with views over Morris Lane and St John's Church respectively. An additional WC completes the layout on this floor, and could be extended into the bedroom to provide an ensuite if needed.

The sunny walled garden enjoys excellent privacy and is designed for easy maintenance and is perfect for al fresco eating and entertaining. There is an outside store with a light, outside tap, a pergola and a climbing honeysuckle.

Situation

Conveniently located in the town, the fabulous Long Street has a splendid selection of period and Listed homes. The property itself sits within a short distance of the Market Place and the renovated Hillworth Park. A historic market town, Devizes has many amenities including town centre shopping, a leisure centre, schools for all ages, various supermarkets, a variety of shops, cinema, theatre and thriving weekly market. The historic Kennet & Avon Canal runs through the town providing fishing and walking opportunities. The major centres of Bath, Salisbury, Swindon, Marlborough and Chippenham are all within a 30 mile radius.
