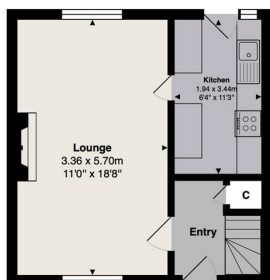

This attractive terraced house on Glenburn Road offers comfortable accommodation in a peaceful yet accessible location, making it an excellent opportunity for a range of buyers.

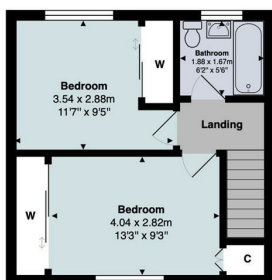

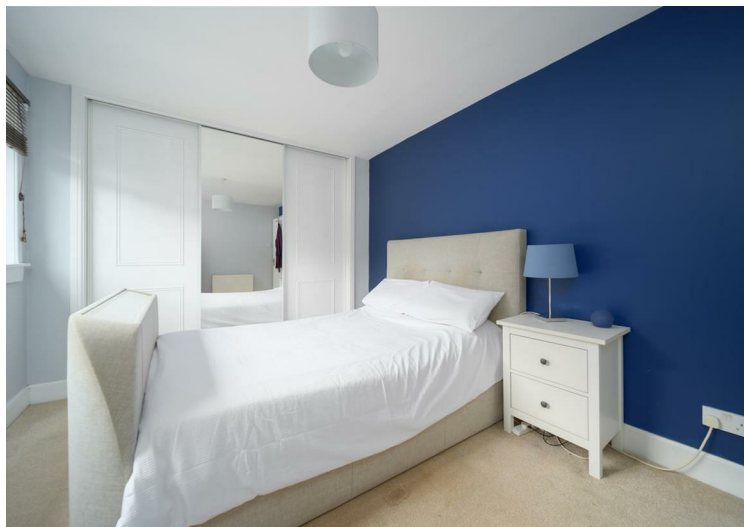
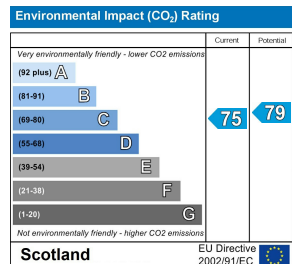
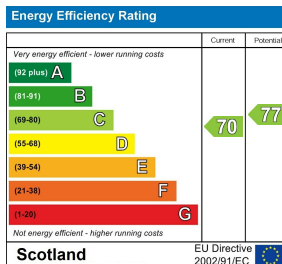




Ground Floor
