About The Property

A modern terraced house built with part brick and part tiled elevations under a tiled roof, situated close to local mini mart, play areas and secondary school.

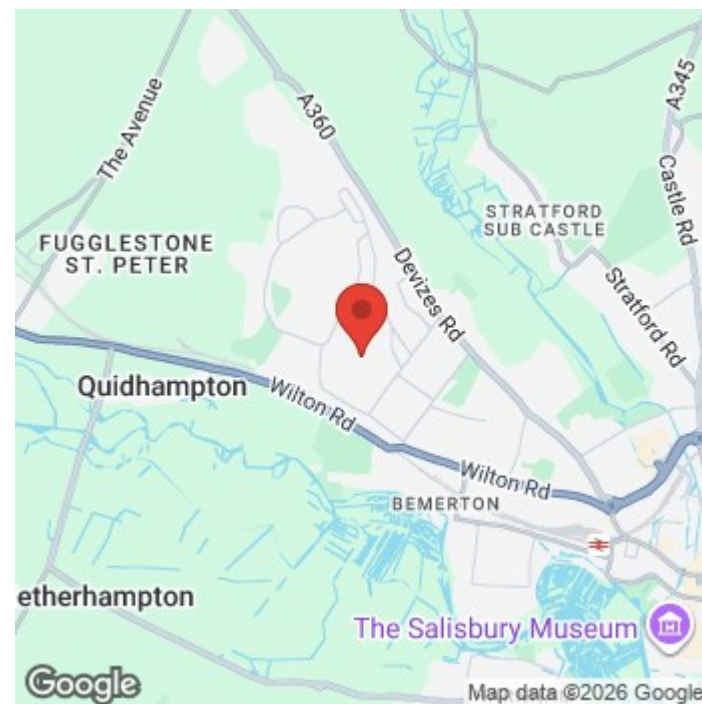
The front garden is set behind a brick wall with timber fencing to sides. It is laid to brick paviors with raised flower beds and there is a wooden garden shed as well as an integral store.

A half glazed front door leads into the kitchen/breakfast room which has a large larder cupboard, work tops and cupboards, built in oven, hob and extractor fan, space and plumbing for washing machine and stainless steel sink unit. The living room lies to the rear of the house with a large window overlooking the rear garden and deep understairs storage cupboard. A door leads to the hallway with door to rear garden and stairs to first floor.

On the first floor are two bedrooms, the main one with a large wardrobe cupboard and a shower room. On the landing is a cupboard housing the hot water tank and a hatch to the loft space.

The rear garden is enclosed by timber fencing with sitting area and pedestrian access gate.

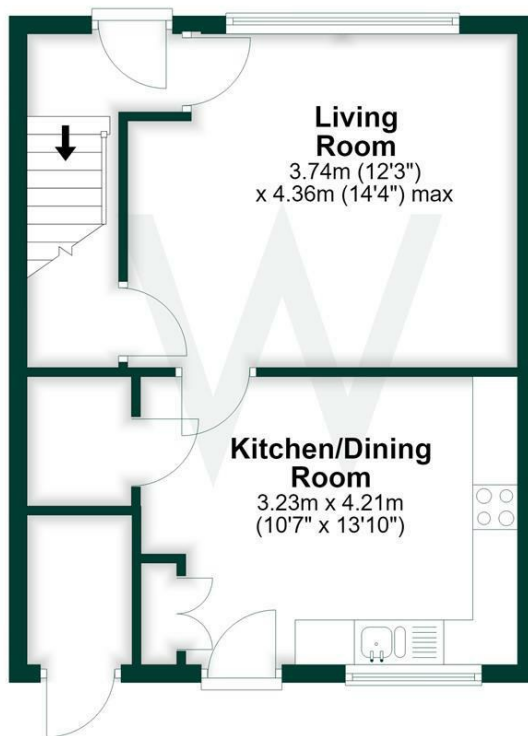

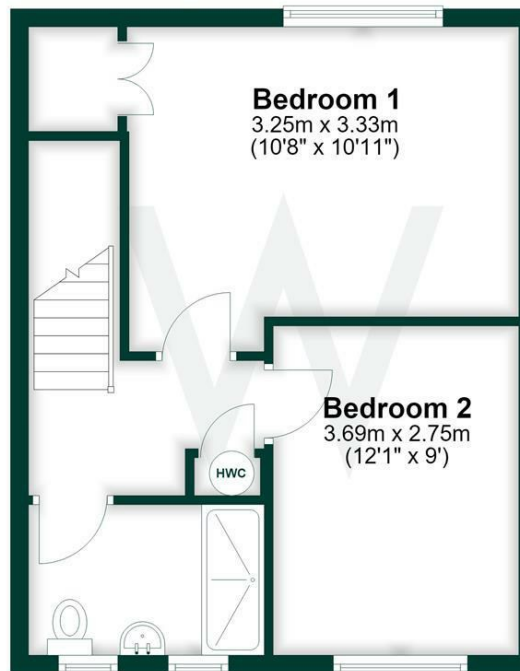
Ground Floor
