A practical utility room off the hall discreetly houses a washing machine and tumble dryer.

Quietly positioned to the rear, the principal bedroom enjoys a tranquil outlook across city rooftops, capturing the Stockbridge landmark of St Stephen's Church and distant hills beyond. Sage-green décor and soft carpeting create a calm retreat, complemented by built-in storage and a stylish en-suite shower room. The en suite is finished with stone-style tiling, ambient lighting, and quality fittings, including a rainfall shower.










Storage, parking and exclusive residents' gardens

The flat benefits from a floored 8 sq. metre attic with ladder access from the hall, alongside private access to a 4 sq. metre under-street cellar. Dundas Street lies within a Controlled Parking Zone, prioritising on-street parking for residents.

Optional key access (available for an annual fee) grants entry to the historic Queen Street Gardens, a beautifully maintained shared green space just moments from the flat.
