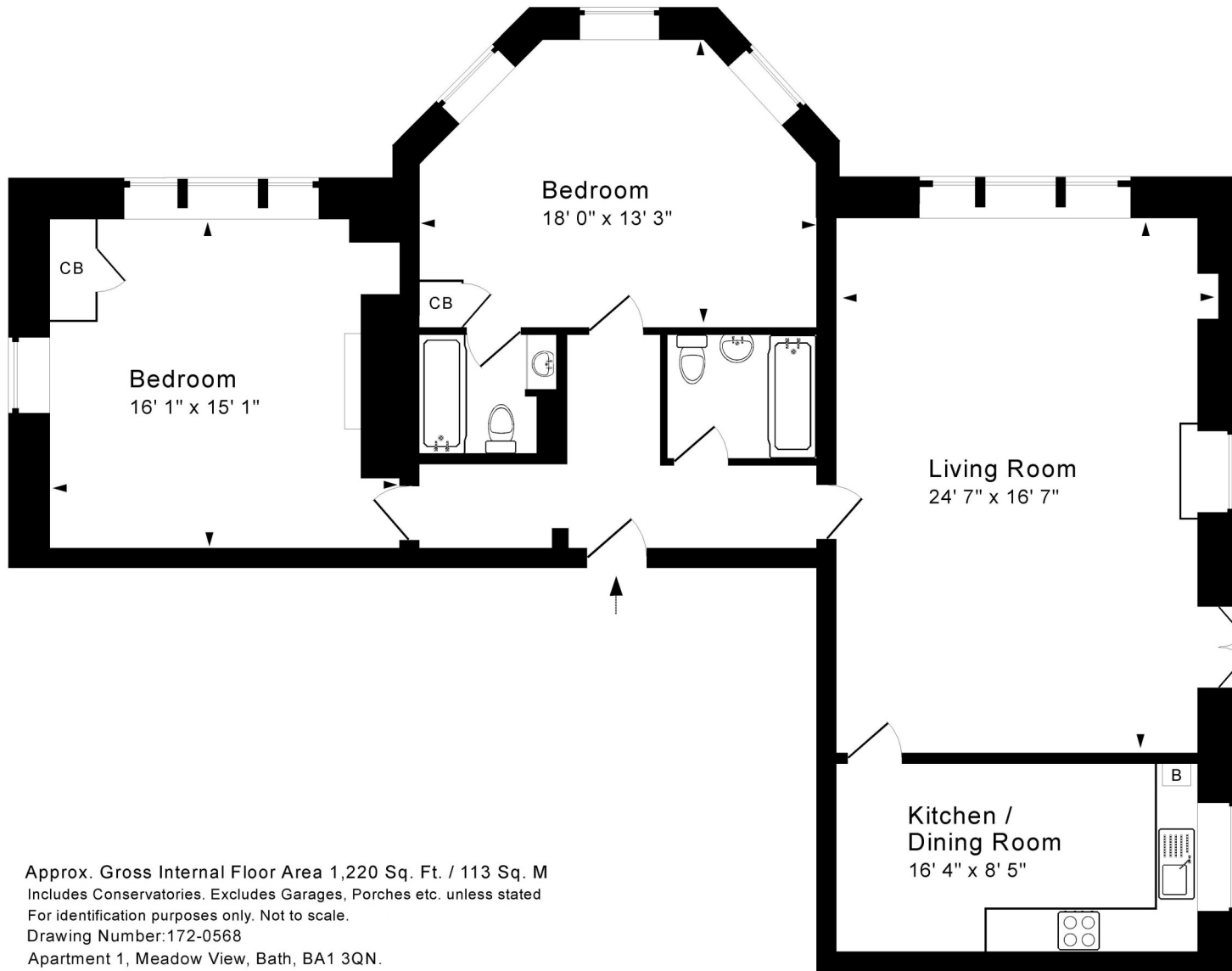
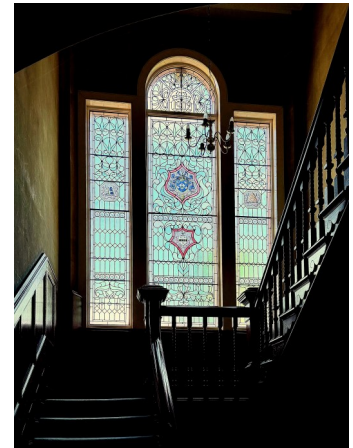
### LOCATION
