ABOUT THE PROPERTY

Upon entering, you are greeted by a welcoming hall with stairs leading to the first floor and access to the main living spaces. The comfortable living room enjoys a lovely bowed window overlooking the front elevation, allowing natural light to fill the space. An electric fire provides a charming focal point, while decorative coving to the ceiling adds a touch of character.

Flowing through from the living room is a well-proportioned kitchen, thoughtfully fitted with a comprehensive range of wall and floor units, complemented by contrasting work surfaces. There is a gas cooker, provision for under-counter fridge and freezer, plumbing for a washing machine, a stainless steel sink with a mixer tap, and a window looking out onto the rear garden. The kitchen also houses the gas central heating boiler and a radiator, ensuring comfort all year round.

The inner hall offers convenient access to the garden, cloakroom, and a spacious walk-in understairs cupboard with lighting.

Upstairs, the landing provides access to the first floor accommodation and to a boarded loft, complete with loft ladders ideal for additional storage.

Three bedrooms await on the first floor: the principal bedroom is positioned to the front elevation and benefits from two cupboards, one with hanging rail and the other with shelving ensuring ample storage for every need. The second bedroom is a rear-facing double boasting delightful garden views, built-in storage, coving, and a radiator for year-round comfort. A third bedroom, a comfortable single looks onto the front elevation.

Completing the upstairs arrangement is a shower room, fitted with a contemporary walk-in shower, pedestal basin, and WC. Partially tiled walls, an obscured window, and a practical radiator add both style and convenience.



Externally, the property is approached by a gravelled forecourt garden and pathway which leads to the front door. To the rear, a raised decking area offers the perfect spot for outdoor dining or relaxation, surrounded by a gravelled garden, raised flowerbed, established shrub borders, and a practical garden shed.

Barnard Castle is renowned for its rich history, picturesque streets, and thriving community. The property is conveniently located for access to a wealth of amenities, including supermarkets, independent shops, cafes, and restaurants. The town itself is famed for its medieval castle, riverside walks, and the stunning Bowes Museum—one of the UK's most notable cultural attractions. 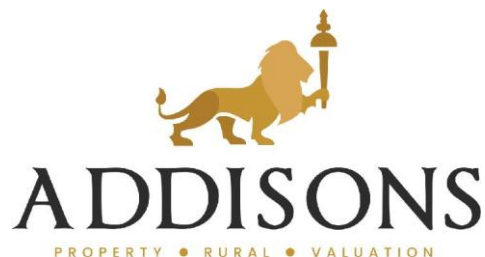

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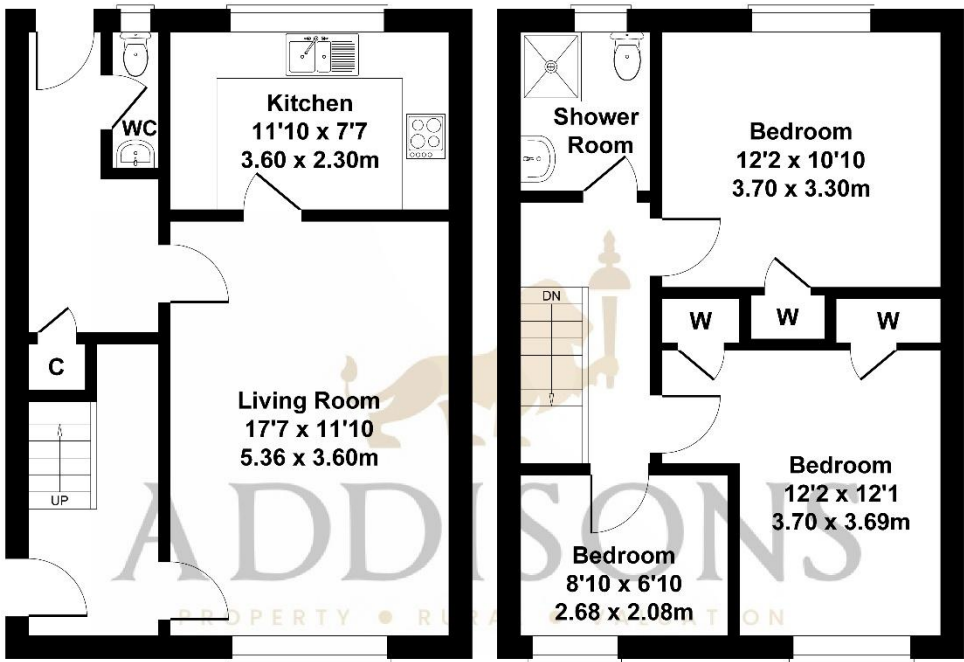
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Floor Plan & EPC
