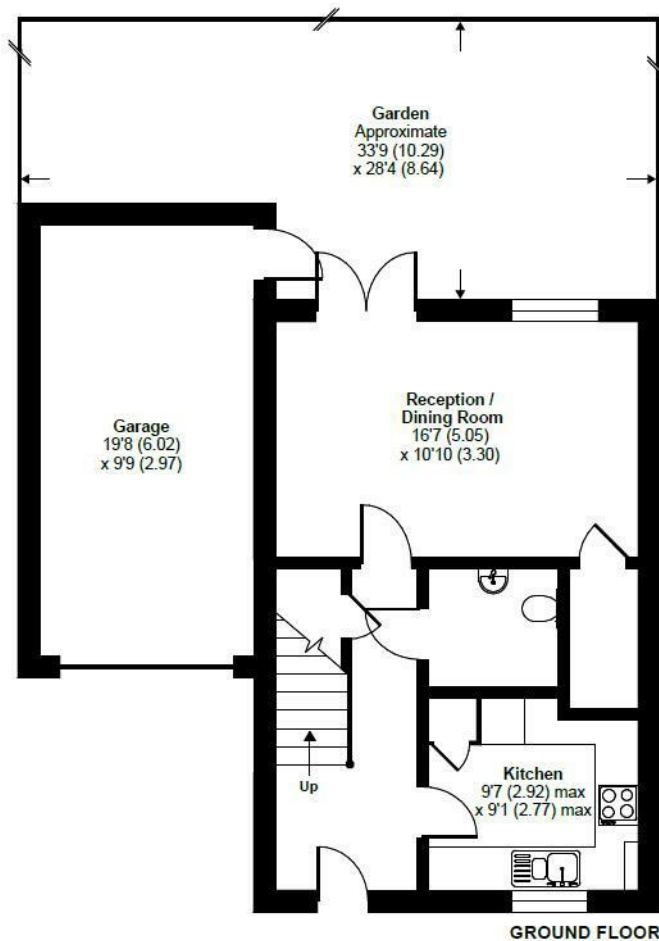

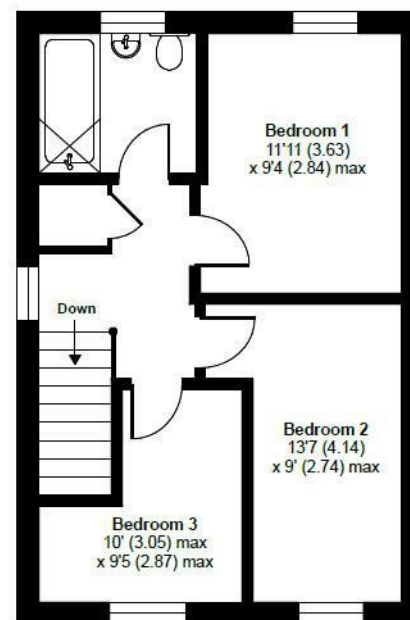

FIRST FLOOR



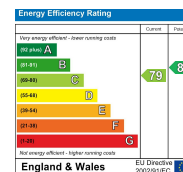
