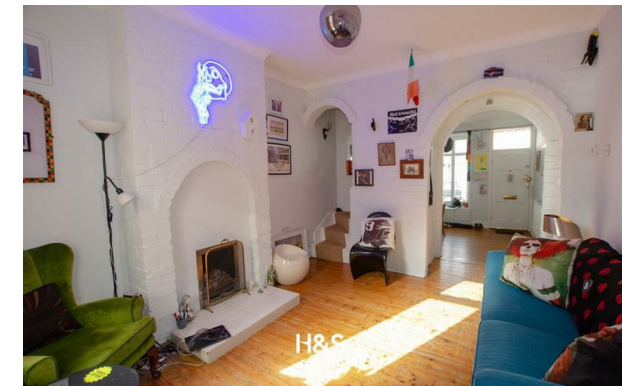

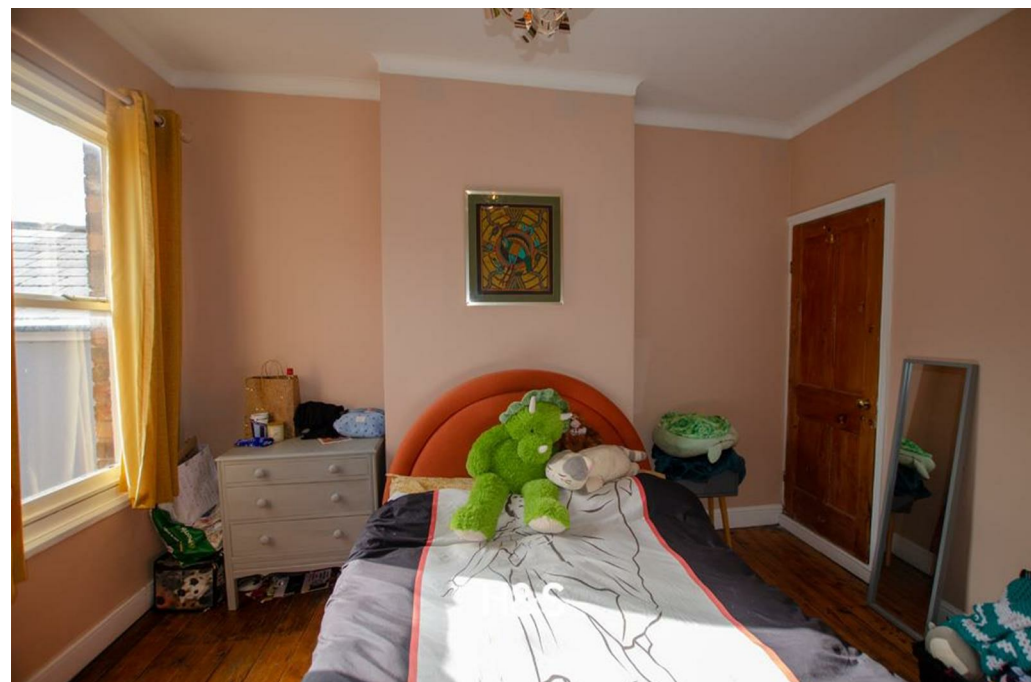

Approach

Via the front garden with steps leading to the front door.

Ground Floor

Reception One

A bright room with a bay window to the front elevation and an opening onto the second reception room

Reception Two

Having a door leading to the stairs, a double glazed window to the rear and a door to the kitchen

Kitchen

There is a range of wall and floor base units with space for appliances. There is a double glazed window to the side, a door leading to the garden and a door leading to the ground floor shower room.

Ground Floor Shower Room

The suite comprises of a walk in shower, a wc and sink. There is cladding to splash prone areas and an obscure double glazed window to the side

First Floor

Bedroom One

There is a window to the front and space for storage

Bedroom Two

Another double bedroom, with a built in cupboard, a double glazed window to the rear and a door leading to the first floor bathroom

First Floor Bathroom

The large bathroom comprises of a paneled bath with shower over, sink, wc and radiator. There are two windows allowing in lots of natural light

Second Floor

Loft Room

A useful room that can be used for storage or an office space. There is storage in the eaves and a velux window.

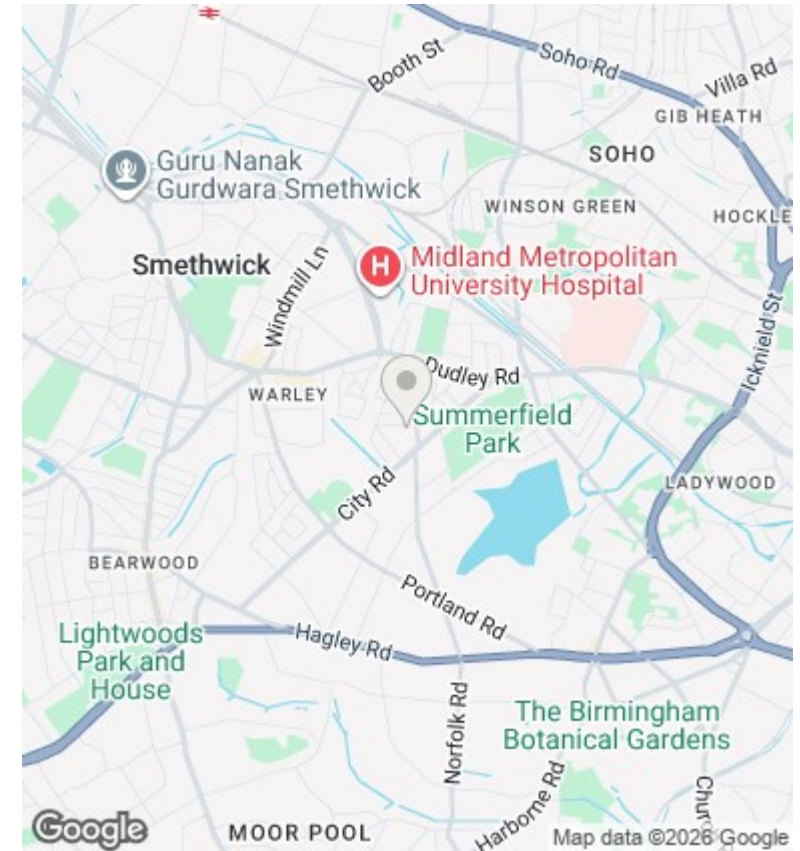
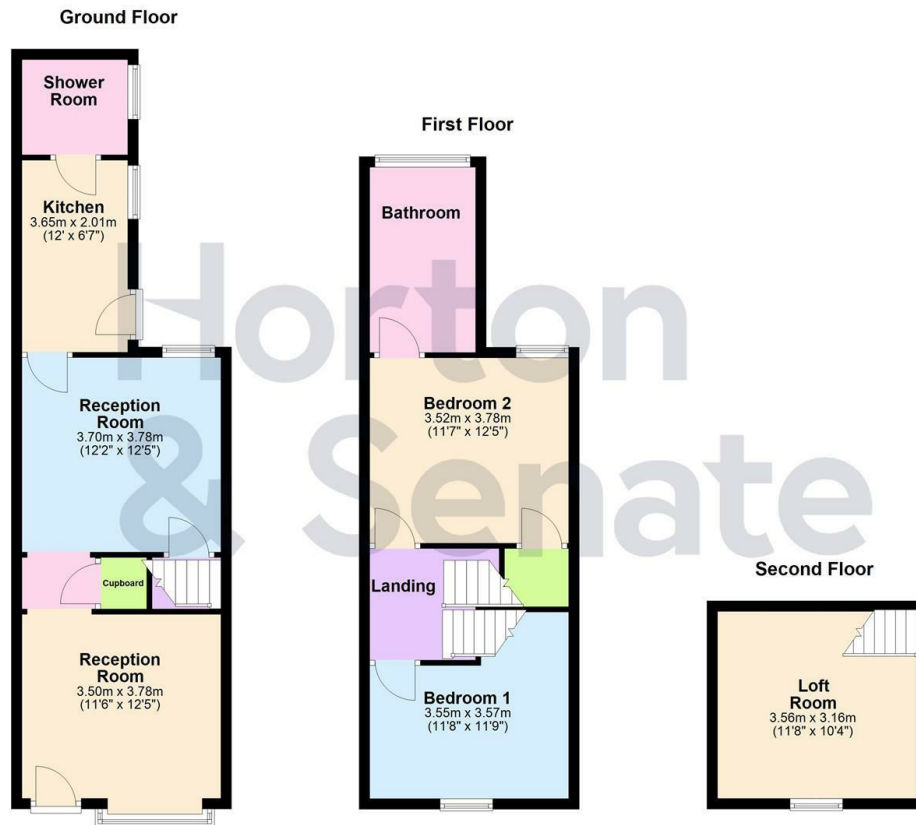
