

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
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IF YOU LIVED HERE...

Sheltered beneath a striking Victorian arch, your own front door gives just enough cover on a rainy day to find your keys without the usual scramble. Step inside and you'll find the first double bedroom at the front - softly carpeted, with twin sash windows and a dramatic dark feature wall that gives the space real atmosphere.

Behind that sits the bathroom: classic and stylish in monochrome. There's a walk-in shower and a freestanding modern bathtub, plus a sleek black vanity with a white basin. White metro tiles with bold grey grout tie it all together beautifully. From here, steps lead down to the shared garden.

Further along the hall, the kitchen feels fresh and modern, a compact but well-planned galley layout with frosted-sage country-style cabinetry running along both sides, thick wooden worktops, and a large sash window filling the space with light.

A second double bedroom offers a calm retreat with soft carpet underfoot and crisp white walls.

At the end of the home, the reception room makes an instant impression. Wooden floorboards run the length of the space, while dado rails, ornate coving, and a cast-iron fireplace set into a midnight-blue feature wall give it character without fuss. It's a

room ready for your own stamp of personality.

Outside, the shared garden is a lovely surprise - part lawn, part paving, dotted with olive trees down the middle. It's the kind of space that shifts easily with the moment: quiet mornings and coffee, or lazy afternoons with friends.

WHAT ELSE?

Nature lovers will appreciate the nearby Walthamstow Wetlands, a sprawling 520-acre nature reserve ideal for peaceful walks and birdwatching.

For nightlife and entertainment, head to the local hub, Patchworks. It's run like a community-led venue that hosts everything from coffee & hangouts, to markets, live music, makers & gallery-type events.
