Dali House is a unique church conversion tucked away on the quiet and residential Huddlestone Road, combining the character of the original building with a beautifully finished, contemporary interior. With high ceilings, lovely natural light, wooden floors and generous proportions, it has a real sense of space and feels wonderfully calm throughout.

The heart of the home is the west-facing open-plan kitchen and reception room, a fantastic space for entertaining, relaxing and everyday living. There is plenty of room for a dedicated dining area and separate TV space, alongside excellent built-in storage. The kitchen is well equipped with a large Bosch integrated induction hob, double fridge freezer and plenty of cupboard space, while a recently installed Worcester boiler is another welcome practical addition.

There are two generous double bedrooms. The principal bedroom has wooden floors, an ensuite bathroom and lovely outlooks, while the second bedroom benefits from built-in storage and excellent ceiling height. A separate three-piece family bathroom completes the accommodation.

One of the things that makes this home particularly special is the combination of character and practicality. The old church setting gives it personality and architectural interest, but the layout works brilliantly for modern living, whether you are a couple, working from home or simply looking for somewhere with enough space to entertain properly.

Huddlestone Road is perfectly placed for everything Willesden Green has to offer. Walm Lane and the High Road provide an excellent selection of local favourites including Gail's Bakery, Sushi Masa, Sanzio, Bottega di Anna, Walnut, Deli Beira, Beer+Burger and Daisy Chain. Gladstone Park is nearby for green open space, tennis courts, outdoor exercise and weekend Park Runs, while Roundwood Park is also within easy reach.

Transport links are excellent, with both Willesden Green and Dollis Hill stations on the Jubilee Line close by, providing easy connections into Central London, alongside numerous bus routes serving the wider area. Families are also well catered for with a good choice of local schools nearby.
