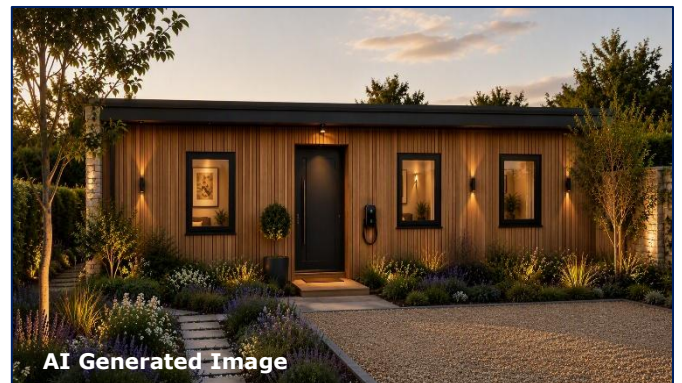
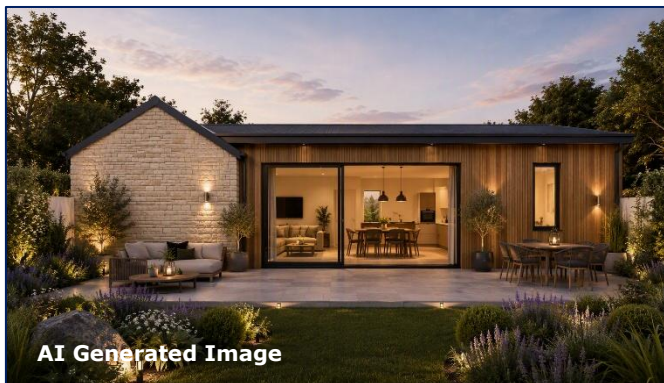


Barn for Conversion, Tremenhere Farm, Stithians, Truro, Cornwall TR3 7DP

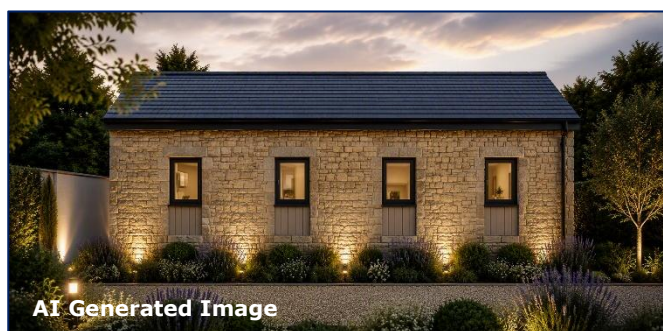
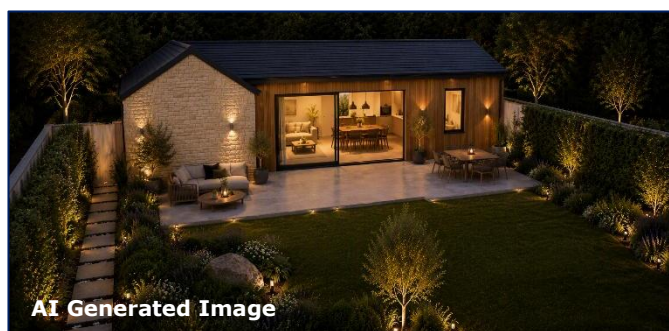

The Property

The beautiful stone elevations have been maintained to a high standard and the roof replaced using natural slates. Mains electricity is already connected and the planning consent allows for private drainage to be installed. The existing canopy is available to purchase by separate negotiation but will otherwise be removed prior to completion of a sale. Planning was granted on 30/04/2025, under Planning Application No. PA24/03474, for the conversion of a store and former concrete aquatics shop with side extension to form a single dwellinghouse.

A wonderful opportunity exists to create a 'one-off' home with a large garden and just three neighbours within what was once a rural farmstead.



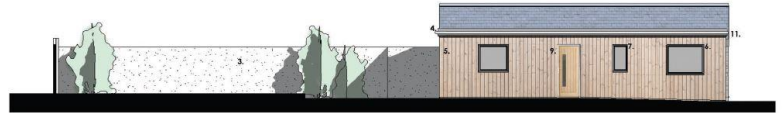

1 : 100



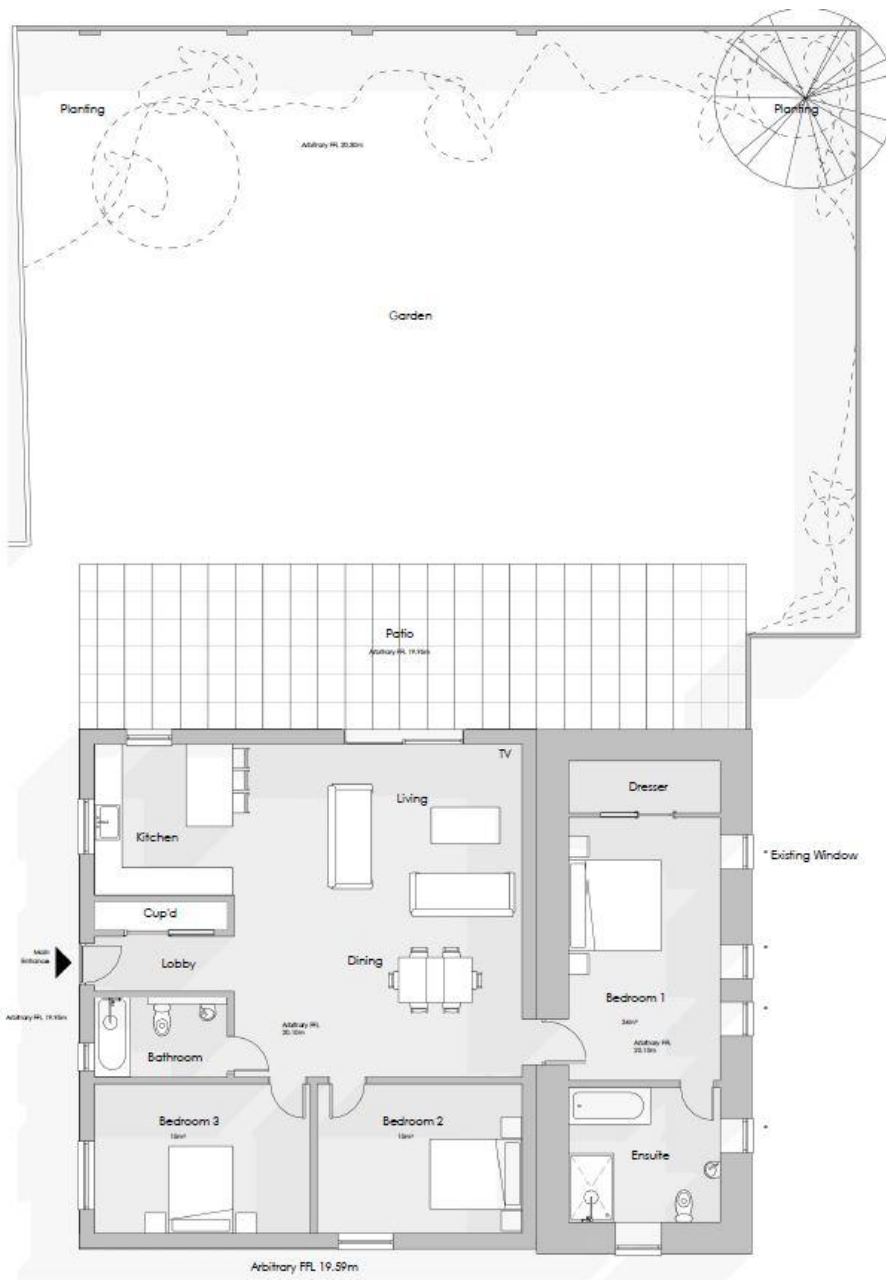
Proposed East Elevation

1 : 100



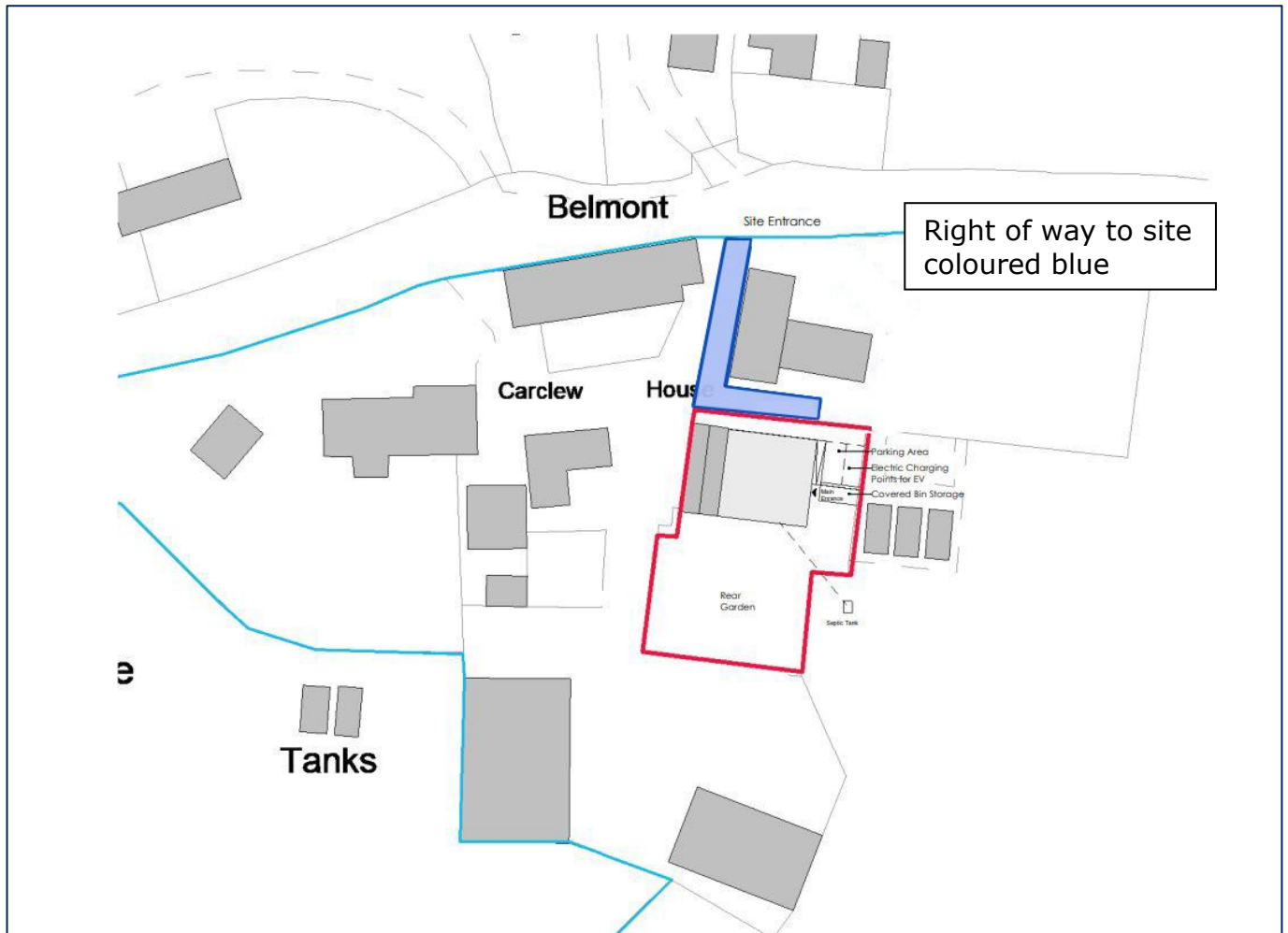
Proposed West Elevation

Location

This lovely semi-rural location is on the eastern fringe of the highly regarded village of Stithians, which itself is situated between the major towns of Truro, Falmouth, Redruth and Helston, all of which are in a 9 mile radius. Whilst well placed for daily commuting to all the schooling, shopping, health and leisure facilities of these towns, the local village amenities include a shop/Post Office, public house, a church and a respected primary school. It is a busy village, popular also for its close proximity to the scenic reservoir and associated countryside walks.
