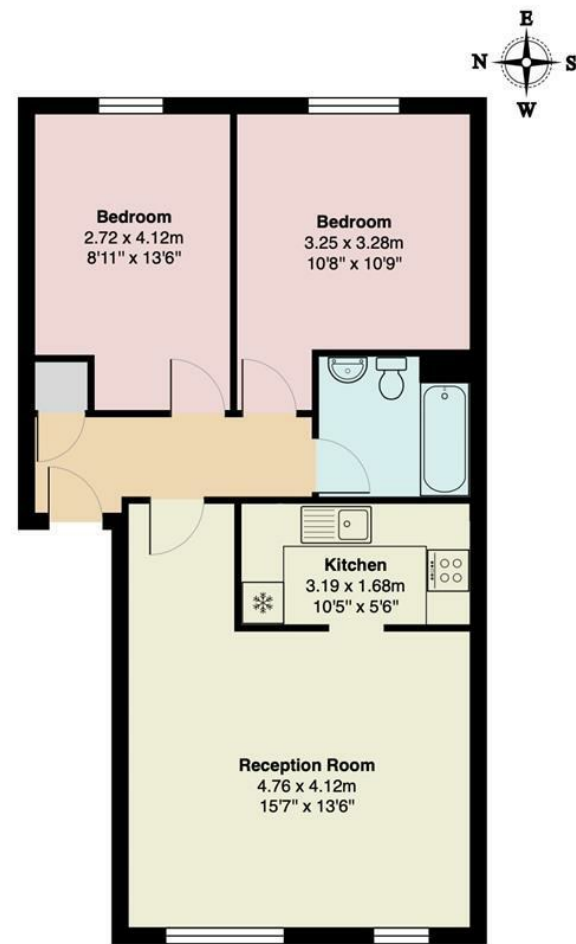
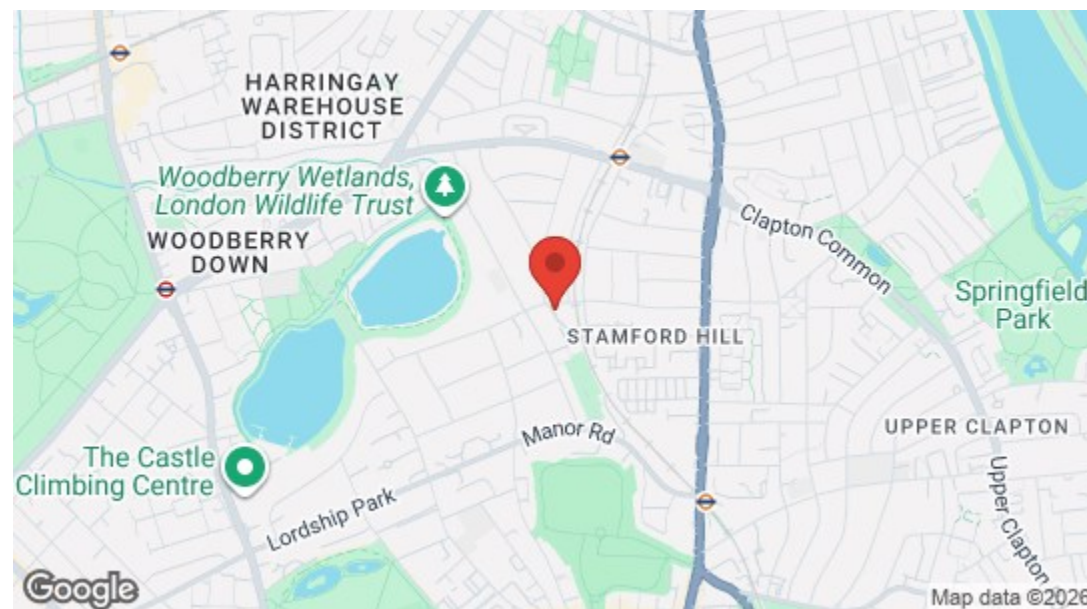

➡ IF YOU LIVED HERE...

You'll be stretching out in your elegantly finished, 180 square foot reception room, lit by twin windows, the pristine white walls and light blonde hardwood underfoot accentuate the sense of light. There's plenty of room for hosting, dining or simply putting your feet up after a long day.

The whole space is laid semi open plan to the kitchen via a modest archway, in here you have a full complement of appliances and a suite of pastel green cabinets. Elsewhere, both bedrooms are substantial doubles with more engineered blonde hardwood underfoot, while your bathroom's a sparkling affair in white and eggshell blue trim.

Outside, the beautiful Woodberry Wetlands nature reserve is within easy walking distance, offering a peaceful haven of reed-fringed waterways, open water and abundant wildlife, with a visitor centre, café and picnic area. Allen's Gardens is also close by for a quiet local escape, while the expansive Clissold Park offers ponds, mature parkland, cafés, tennis courts, children's facilities and its much-loved deer enclosure. Further east, Springfield Park provides formal gardens, sports facilities and far-reaching views across the River Lea and Walthamstow Marshes, with riverside walks and cycling routes beyond.

Stamford Hill Overground station is also close by, with direct trains to Liverpool Street taking as little as 17 minutes, putting the City within easy reach.
