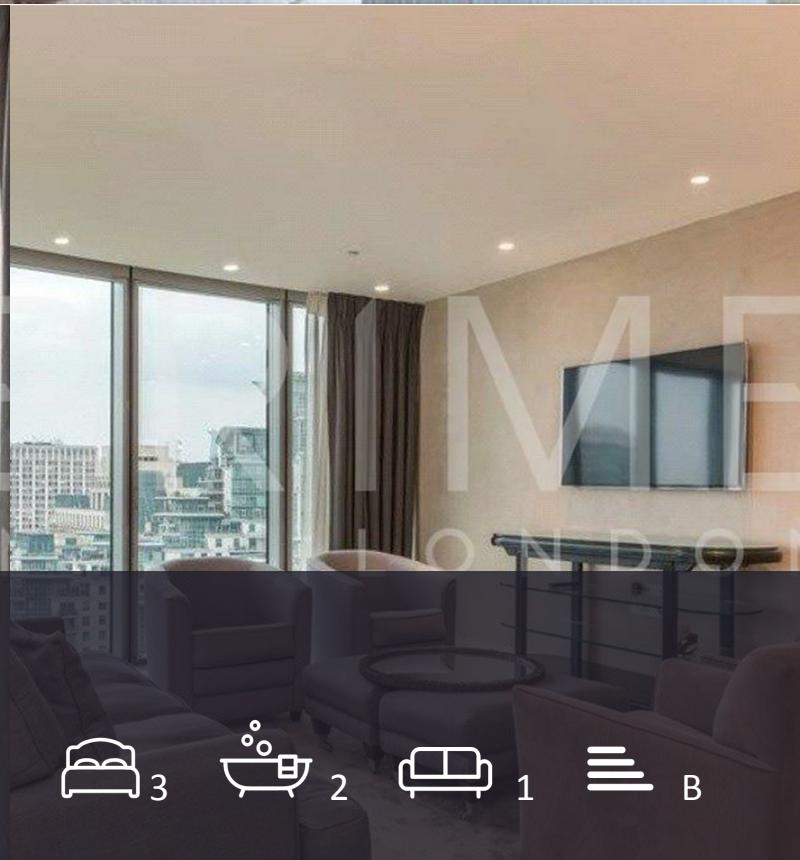

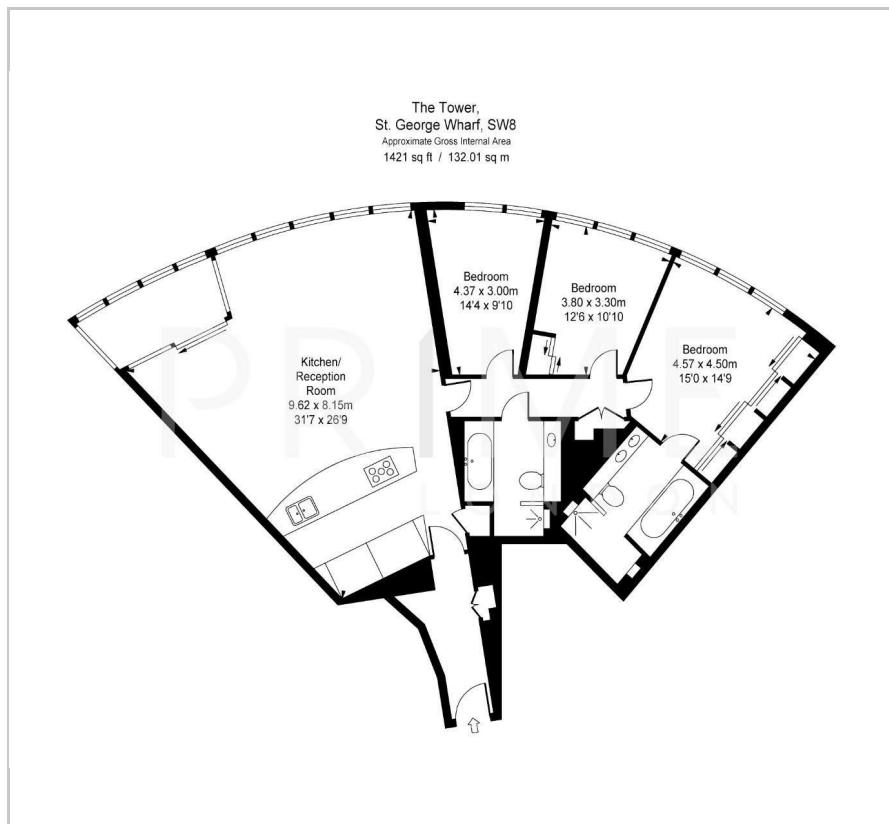

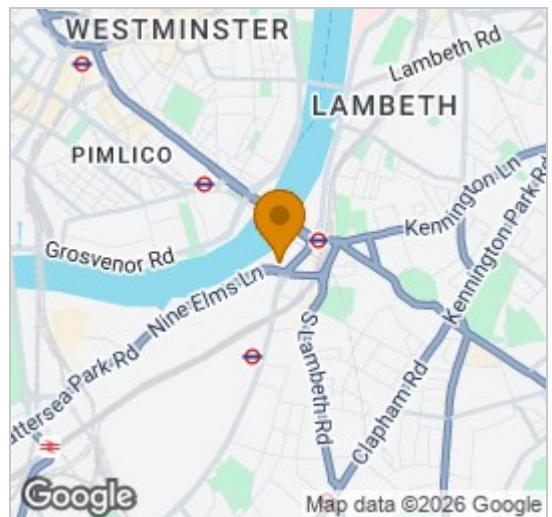

Area Map



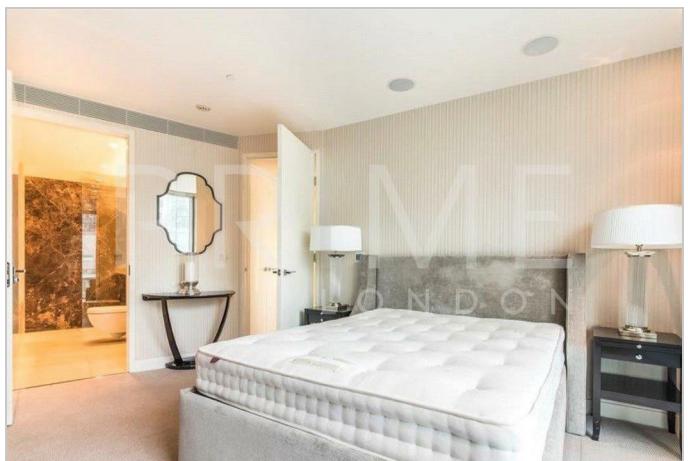
