A unique and rare opportunity to acquire a superb first floor apartment set within the iconic Campion House, one of Isleworth's most recognisable landmark developments, located in the heart of the Spring Grove Conservation Area. The building features an impressive and elegant communal entrance hallway, creating a striking sense of arrival. The apartment offers 1,326 sq ft of well proportioned internal accommodation, comprising two generous double bedrooms and two contemporary bathrooms, finished to a high standard throughout.

Ideally located in Isleworth, offering convenient access to local shops, cafés and restaurants, as well as Isleworth and Syon Lane stations, providing links into London Waterloo. The open green spaces of Syon Park and the River Thames are also close by.

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A particular highlight is the exceptional private roof terrace measuring approximately 323 sq ft, providing breathtaking views of the communal gardens. Residents also benefit from secure gated access, allocated parking, and access to the beautifully maintained communal grounds, featuring expansive lawns and a central ornamental fountain. Originally constructed in 1856 as Thornbury House, Campion House later became a significant Jesuit college following its acquisition in 1911, before being sensitively converted into luxury apartments in the early 21st century carefully preserving its historic character while delivering refined modern living.
