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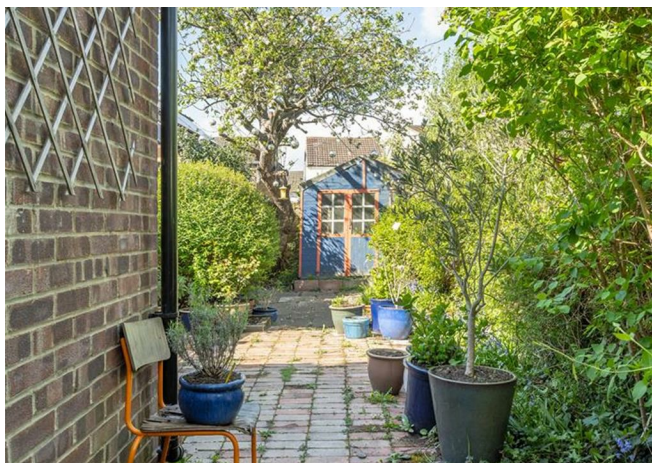
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IF YOU LIVED HERE...

At home, your reception area is bright and airy with spotless decor, timber flooring, bespoke carpentry and a stunning mantelpiece with a wood burner stove. Head through into the kitchen and you'll find the same pristine finish, with sleek units, glossy worktops and an integrated oven. Beyond, you'll find similar contemporary style in your bathroom, including an over-tub shower and floor to ceiling tiles.

Upstairs, you've got two immaculately decorated bedrooms, and don't forget your charming garden at the rear... Thanks to the leafy climbers and mature foliage, the private space has a wonderfully secluded feel, with the bricked paving and colourful outhouse adding to the enchantment.

Despite being on a peaceful, tree-lined street, you only have to walk a few minutes down your road to enjoy Hoe Street's thriving food and drink scene. Choose between the award-winning Yard Sale Pizza, Sodo and Shri Lakshmi if you fancy dining out or ordering takeaway to have in your fantastic home. Or hop down to Walthamstow Village for even more options. Ruff's Bistro on Orford Road would make a great place for a celebratory moving in meal.

Don't forget that you're just a short hop and a skip from Lloyd Park, where you'll find a skate park, playground, tennis courts, bowls club, dog park, cafes and the William Morris Gallery.

And if you need to travel beyond E17, it couldn't be easier; Walthamstow Central station is around 0.5 miles on foot and allows quick and direct access to both Oxford Circus and Liverpool Street via the Victoria line and Weaver Overground respectively.

WHAT ELSE?

-Walthamstow Central has brilliant amenities, including Forest Cinema and the chains found in the 17&Central shopping centre. Hoe Street also has some fantastic perks, with the Soho Theatre Walthamstow set to be open by the time you move in.
- While you wait for the Soho Theatre Walthamstow to open, you can still enjoy some excellent entertainment at the wonderfully eclectic Trades Hall, a favoured spot for renowned comedians to perform warm-up sets. Ye Olde Rose & Crown also puts on some excellent shows, including annual pantos. Both venues are a few mins on foot.
- If exercise is on the agenda as well as food, you'll be pleased to hear that there are some excellent facilities, including yoga studio East of Eden and modern leisure centre the Feel Good Centre.
