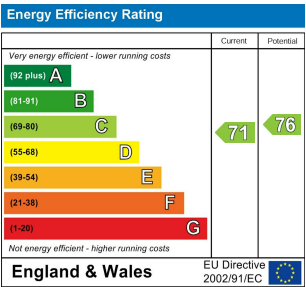
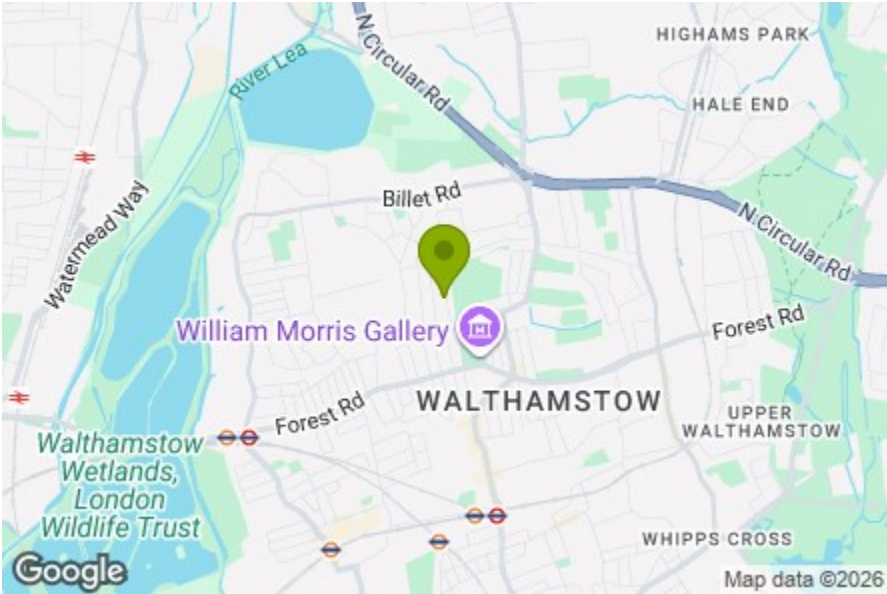

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IF YOU LIVED HERE...

Your new home presents an attractive period frontage, with warm brickwork and decorative arches that lend elegance and charm. A recessed doorway beneath a curved archway completes the inviting first impression. Inside, the hallway stretches the length of the home with wooden floorboards underfoot and crisp white walls keeping the space bright and uncluttered. A built-in cupboard provides useful storage while leading naturally into the living areas. Filled with daylight from tall sash windows, the reception room is softened by neutral tones. Timber floors and bespoke shelving add warmth and character, creating a versatile space that works as well for quiet evenings as it does for entertaining. Peaceful and restful, the bedroom benefits from a sash window that draws in plenty of brightness. Wooden flooring adds texture and complements the fresh palette, making it a simple yet inviting retreat. Towards the rear, the kitchen is a particularly appealing highlight, beautifully illuminated by a wall of glazing and a door that opens directly to the outdoor space. Soft-toned cabinetry sits in harmony with the rich patina of the timber floor, and the generous layout allows the room to feel both practical and comfortable. Glossy brick-style tiling in muted shades gives the bathroom a serene and refined atmosphere. A window enhances the sense of daylight, while an adjoining wet room offers a contemporary walk-in shower. Beyond the home, the shared garden stretches to an ample length with a paved

terrace and lawn framed by mature greenery, providing a leafy backdrop for relaxation and dining. Set within a lively corner of Walthamstow, the home is surrounded by green spaces, culture, and an ever-growing mix of independent spots to enjoy. Just a few minutes away lies Lloyd Park, home to the William Morris Gallery, tennis courts, and a much-loved weekend market that brings the community together. Nearby, Buhler and Co offers a relaxed setting for brunch, while The Bell remains a firm local favourite for drinks. For something different, the Soho Theatre has a base in Walthamstow, bringing comedy, theatre, and performance to the neighbourhood. A little further afield, the wide open landscapes of Walthamstow Wetlands, the characterful pubs and eateries of Walthamstow Village, and the Big Penny Social on the Walthamstow Beer Mile add even more to explore.

WHAT ELSE? Walthamstow Central is just over fifteen minutes away, offering swift connections across London via the Victoria line and Overground services. Numerous bus routes also serve the neighbourhood, linking you easily with surrounding areas such as Hackney, Leyton, and Stratford. With such strong transport links close at hand, the home is well placed for both commuting and exploring the wider city.
